






Haul Route

The B-Line from station 22+97 to 57+97 shall be treated with water for dust abatement upon request from the Contract Administrator. Road construction will not be permitted from October 1 to April 1 unless authorized in writing by the Contract Administrator. The hauling of forest products will not be permitted from October 1 to April 1 unless authorized in writing by the Contract Administrator. Hauling restriction applies only to haul on the B-1000. Hauling timing restrictions are described as: no operations of heavy equipment within the critical nesting season (April 1 to August 31) during the daily peak activity period (one hour before official sunrise to two hours after official sunrise and one hour before and after official sunset) on the B-Line. Heavy equipment is defined as felling, yarding, and loading equipment for logging, and road maintenance and construction equipment.






Forested Wetland


