



- Bases of the Assessment
 - CPL and Agency Strategic Priority Proviso ESSB 6095
 - RCW 79.10.090 Economic analysis of state lands held in trust
- Contractor Deloitte Transactions and Business Analytics LLP
 - Sub contractor Earth Economics
- Data analysis complete
- Report in preparation
- Due June 30, 2020
 - Delayed November 1, 2020 due to COVID-19

Update – DNR's work on Climate and Carbon

Climate

- Agency
 - Climate Risk Assessment
 - Conducted 2012-2016
 - Climate Resiliency Plan
 - Published 2020
- Focus on State Trust Lands (examples)
 - Developing seed management and reforestation approaches
 - Implementing DNR's 20-year forest health strategy
 - Enhancing water rights and flexibility
 - Promoting wind and solar energy generation

Carbon

- Agency
 - Natural and Working Lands Carbon Sequestration Advisory Group (CSAG)
 - Carbon inventories
 - Compile information on existing opportunities for carbon sequestration program
 - Recommend to Legislature (Dec 2020) improvements to existing programs
- Focus on State Trust Lands (examples)
 - Funded Forest carbon inventory for WA with USDA Forest Service FIA
 - Conducted carbon sequestration analysis as part of WWA sustainable harvest
 - Continue to explore current carbon market mechanisms
