SUBJECT: **SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Bologna Timber Sale #105951 and Forest Practice Application #2819263 proposal is a variable retention harvest of approximately 3,928 MBF on approximately 97.1 acres. The proposal includes approximately 4,412 feet of road construction, 4,928 feet of road reconstruction, up to 1,251 feet of temporary road construction (road to be abandoned after completion of if built), 3,277 feet of existing road to be abandoned after completion of use and 92,922 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Located in Sections 01, 02, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, Township 29 North, Range 07 East, and Section 06, 07, 08, 18, Township 29 North, Range 08 East, W.M., Snohomish County.
