This is a re-authorization of an existing lease.

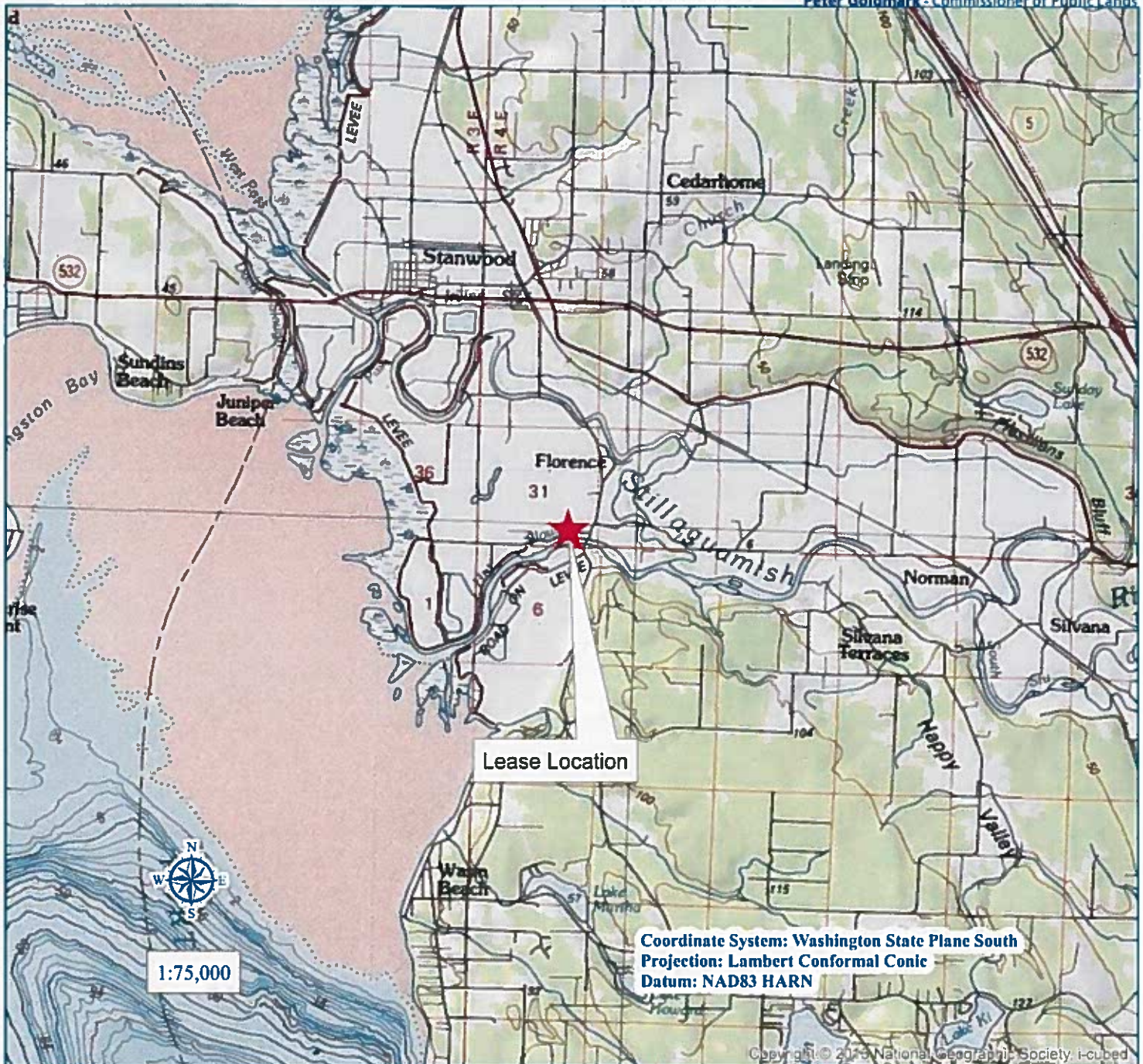
