## **Board Composition and Membership Qualifications**

## **Authority: DNR Internal Initiative**

- The Committee shall include at least 5 members and up to 7 members. At a minimum the Committee will include:
  - o DNR's Product Sales and Leasing Division Manager –
  - o One member from the University of Washington or WSU Real Estate Program
  - o Two members from reputable private sector commercial real estate firms
  - One member from an investment fiduciary with commercial real estate holdings

Per charter requirements, members will be professionals of varying backgrounds whose expertise brings added perspective to those responsible for the management of the DNR real estate portfolio.

The members will be asked to propose methods to improve the performance and strategic direction of the Commercial Real Estate portfolio. To be effective therefore, members must have experience in commercial real estate valuation, investment or management of a diversified portfolio of real estate assets. It is appropriate for some membership experience to be in public sector real estate management, as the CRE program is governed by a number of state laws and statutes.
