DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

At Fruitland, WA, turn east off Hwy 25 onto Fruitland Valley Road travelling approximately 5.5 miles to the intersection of Fruitland Valley Road and Turk Road. Continue east on Fruitland Valley Road for approximately 3.3 miles. Fruitland Valley Road becomes a non-maintained county road. Continue travelling past the Deer Trail Mine site to the intersection of the E293701E Road. Turn on to the E293701E Road. Travel for approximately 0.6 miles to the intersection of the E293712F Road.

Unit 2: Turn North on the E293712F Road and travel approximately 0.8 miles.

Unit 1, the upper portion of Unit 2 and Unit 3: From the intersection of E293701E and E293712F Roads, continue west on the E293701E Road approximately 0.5 miles. At the top of the ridge, turn east on the E293712E road and continue approximately 0.7 miles to the intersection with the E293807E Road.
