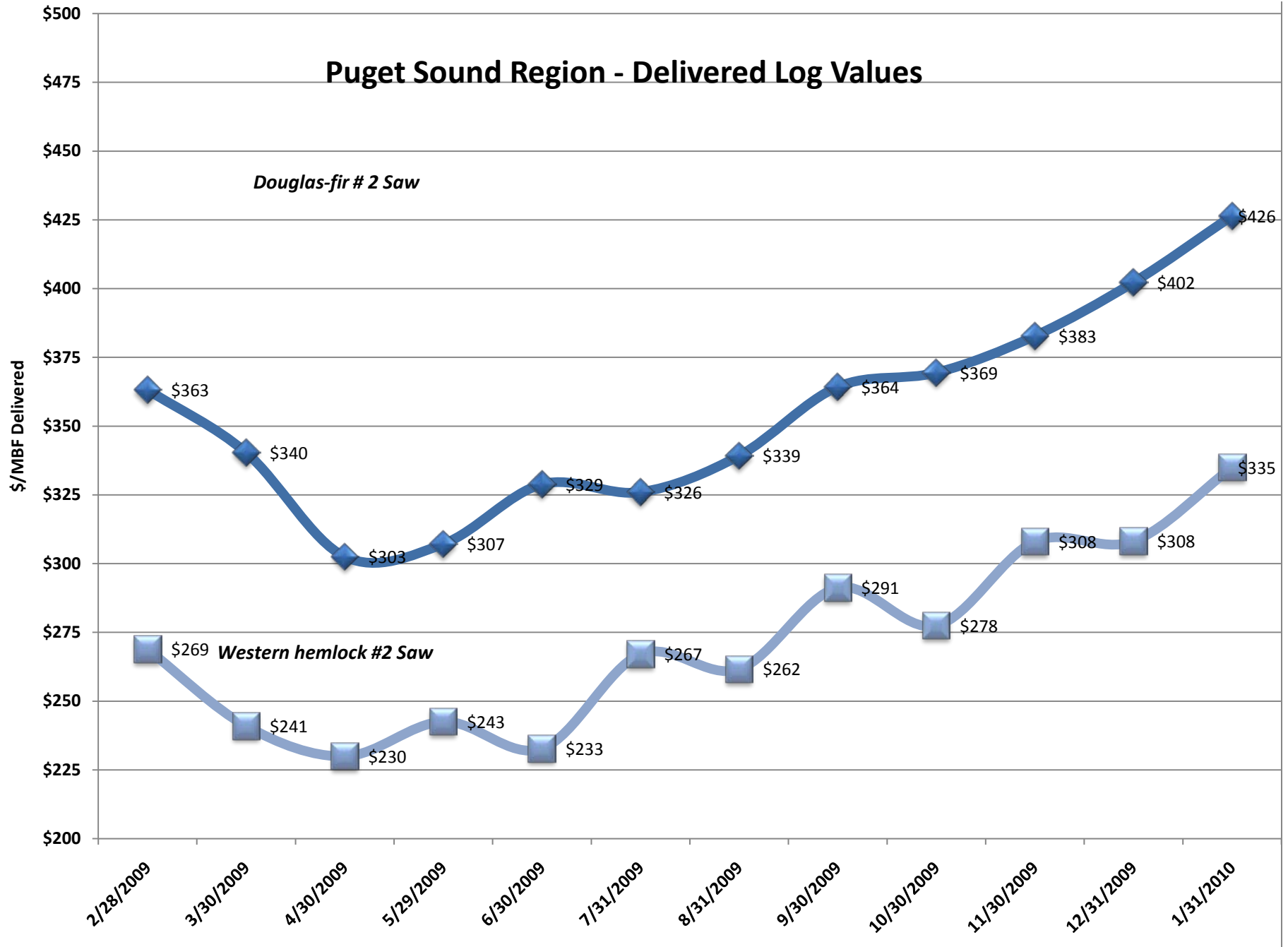

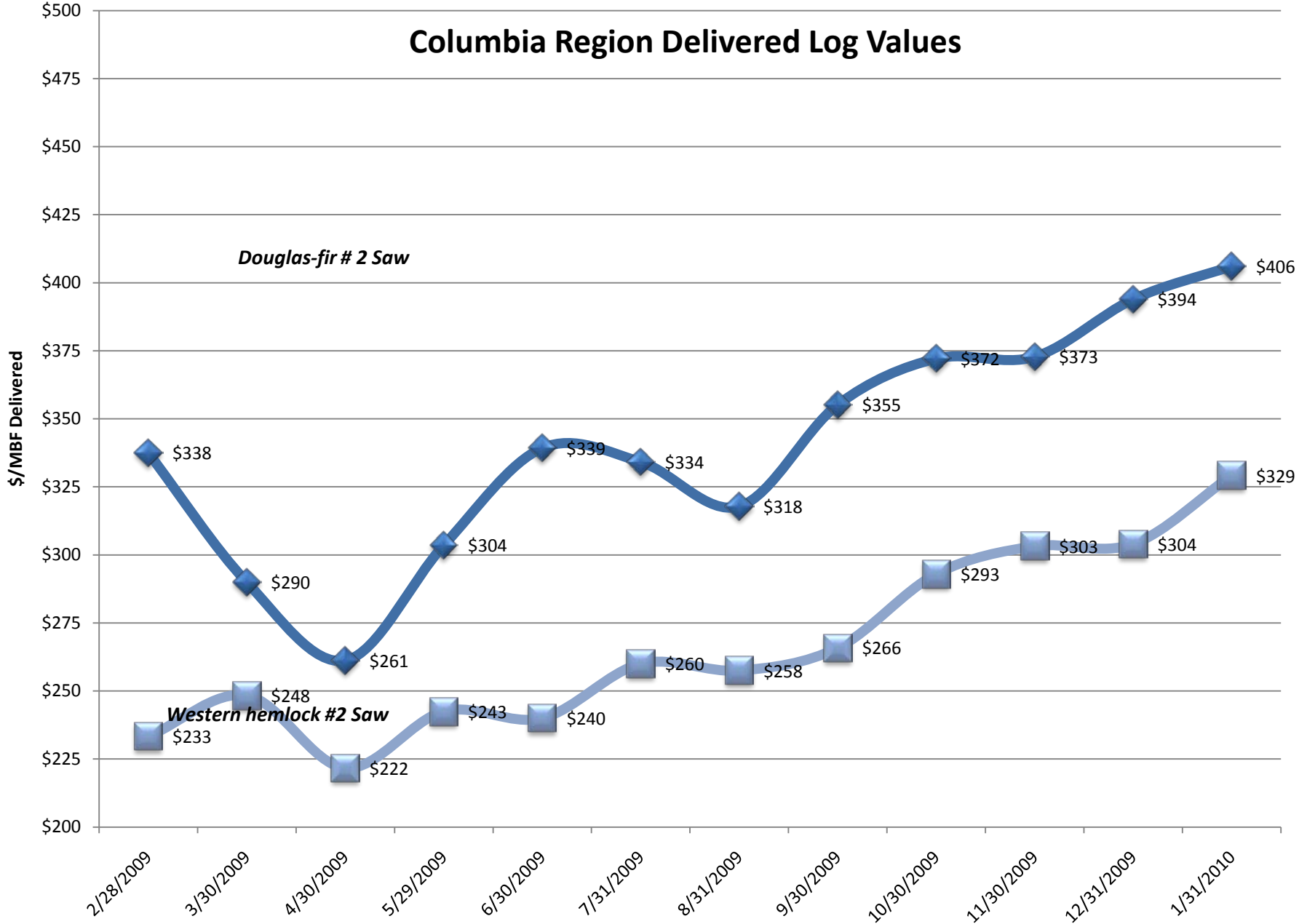

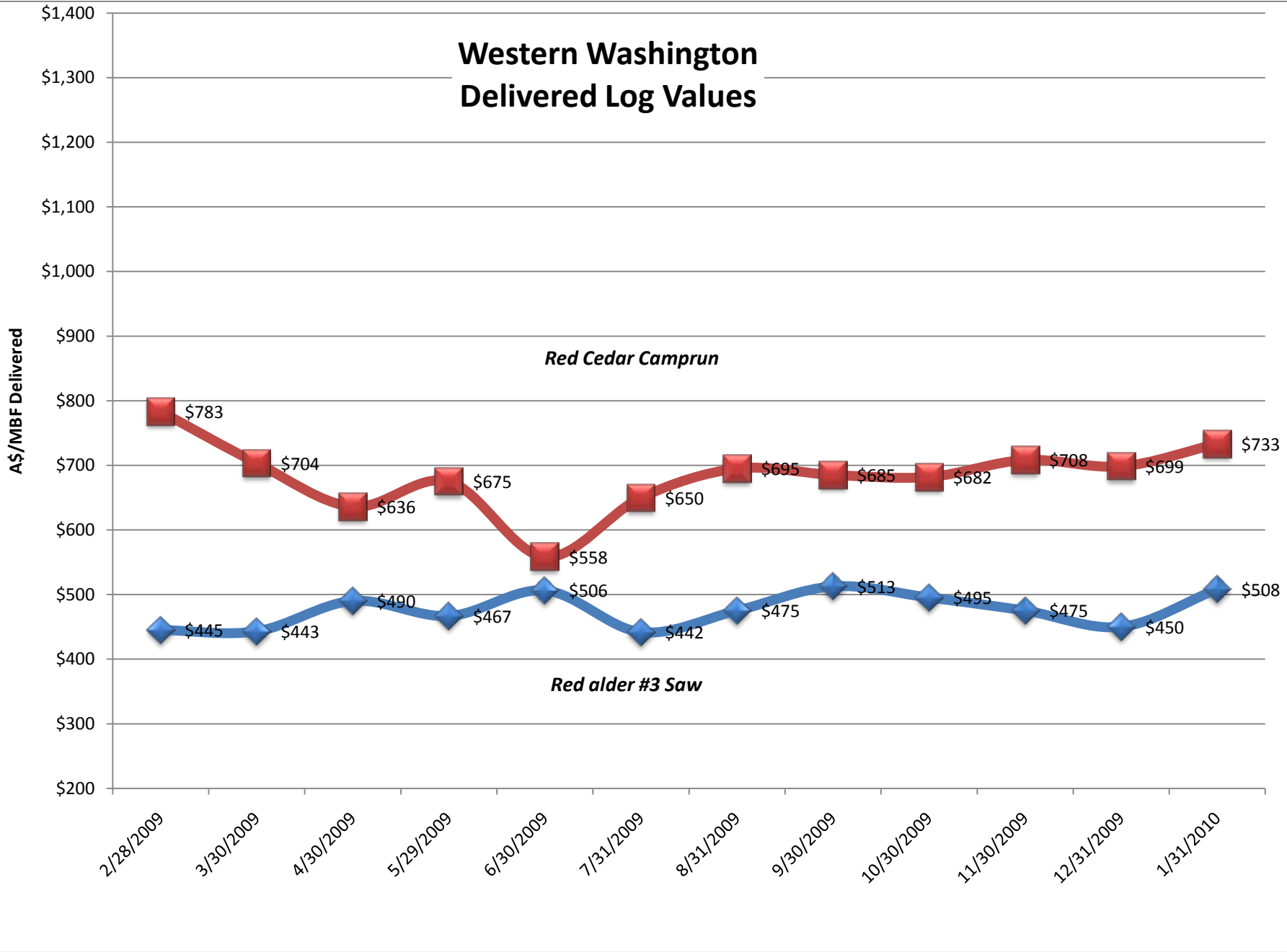
Puget Sound Region - Delivered Log Values

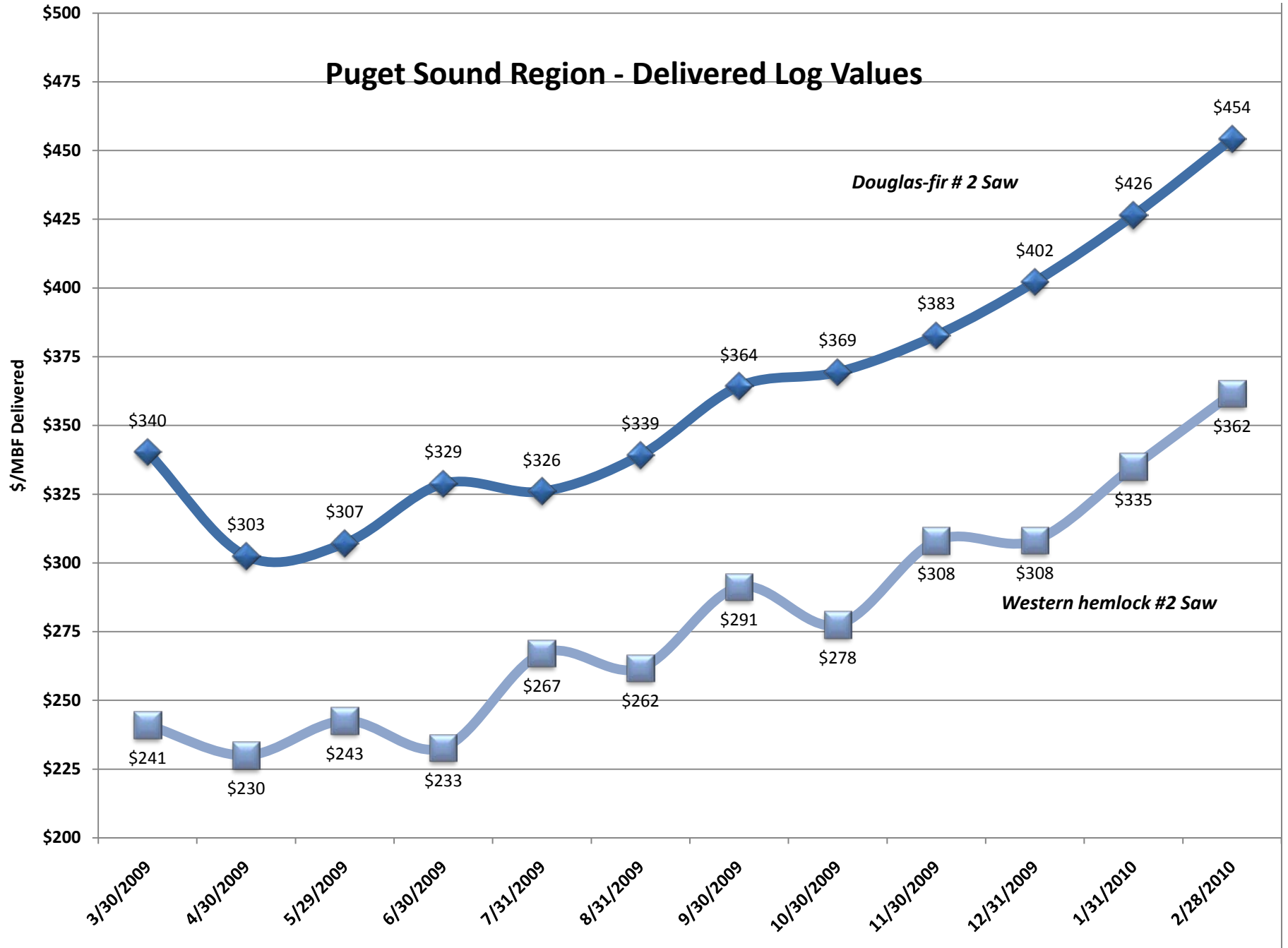
Western Washington Delivered Log Values

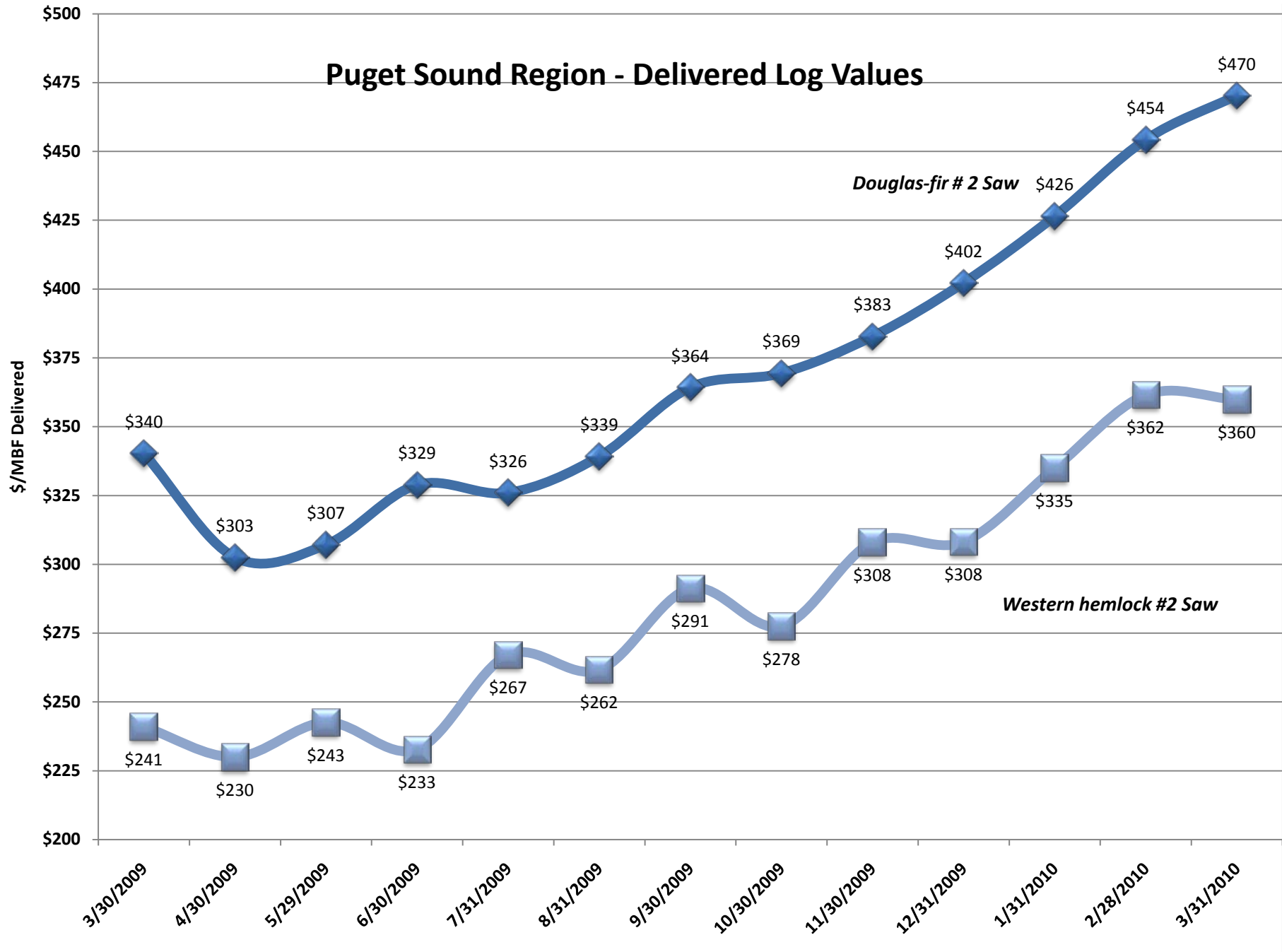
Western Washington Delivered Log Values

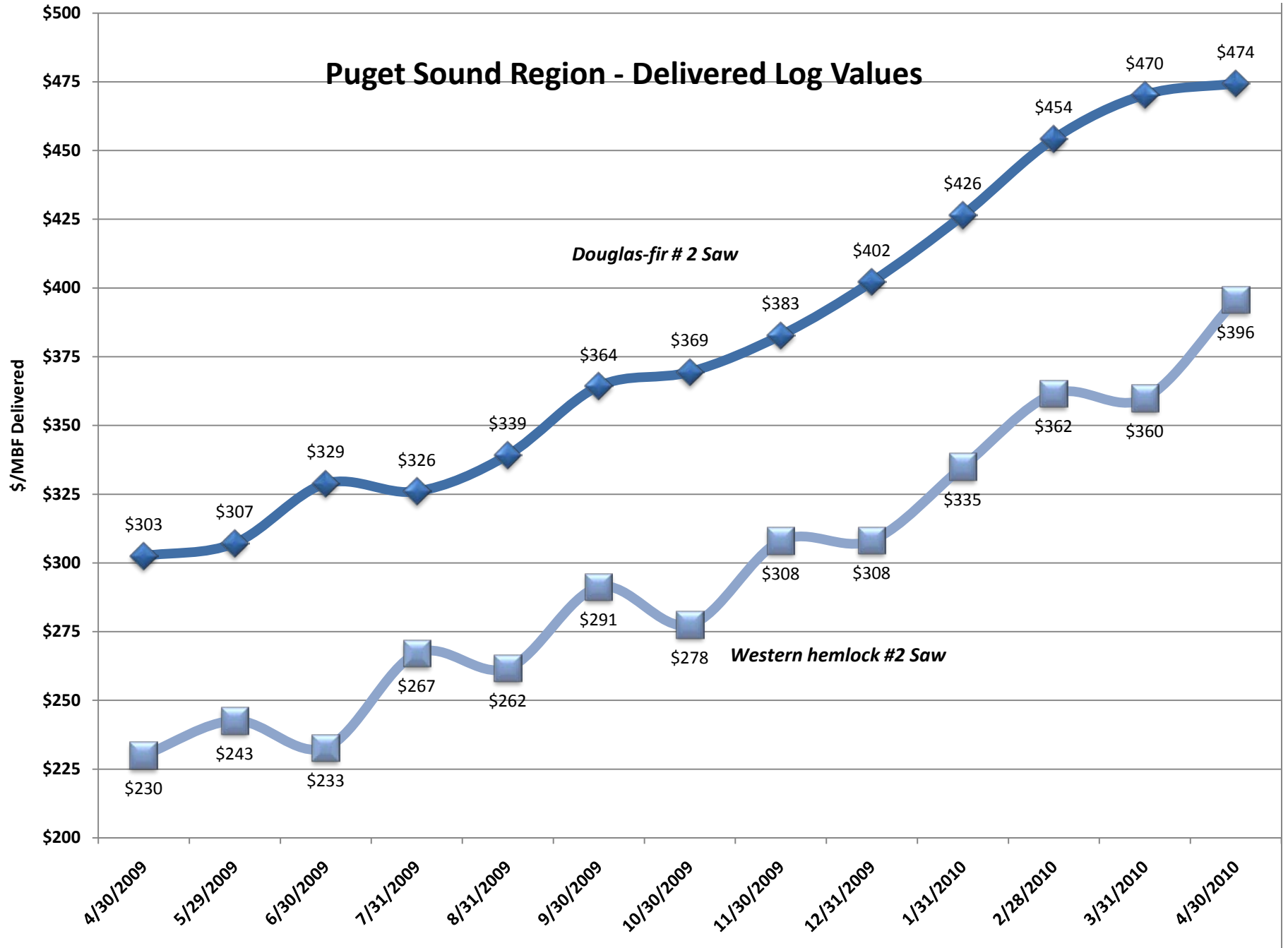
Western Washington Delivered Log Values

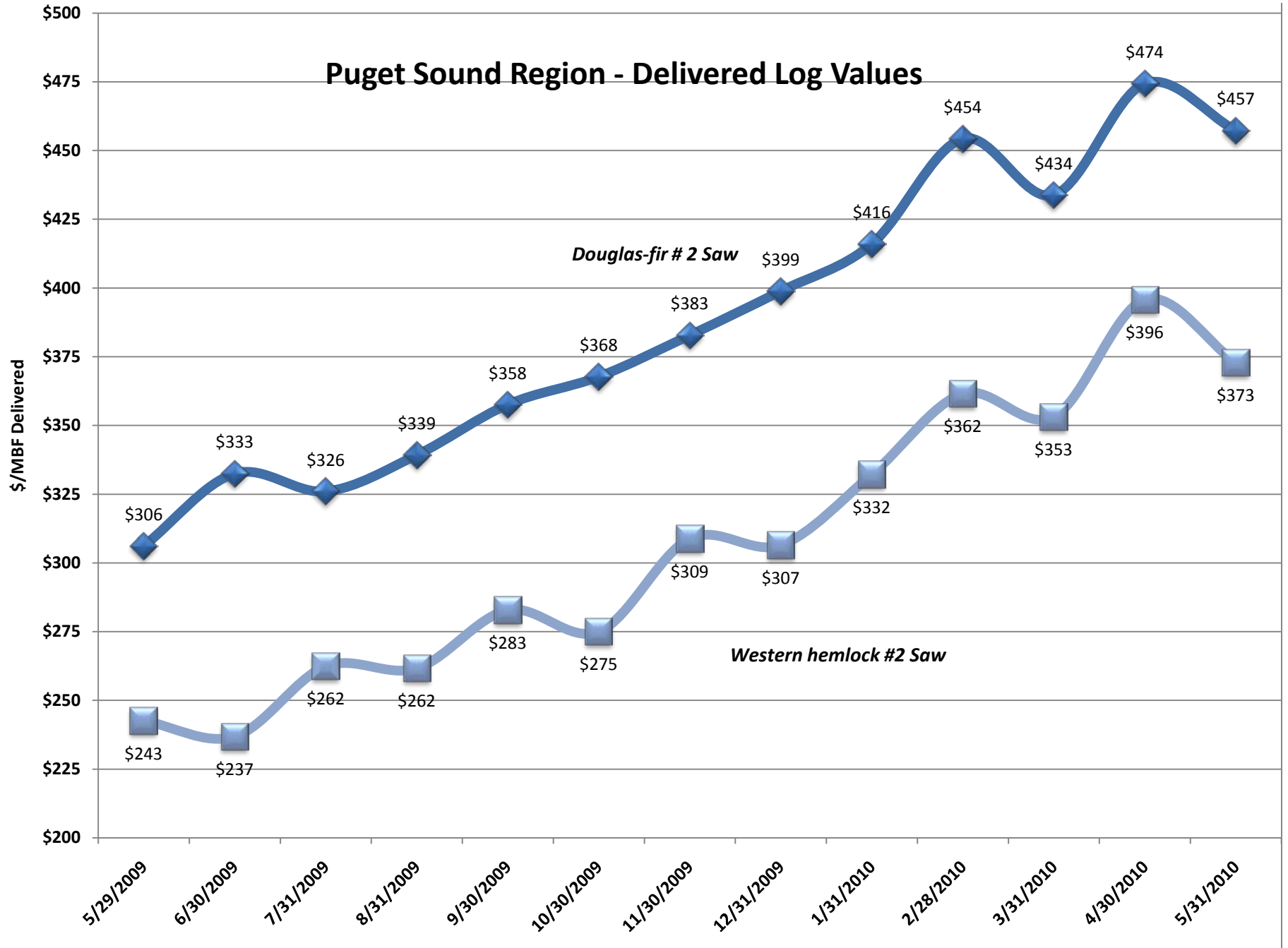
Western Washington Delivered Log Values

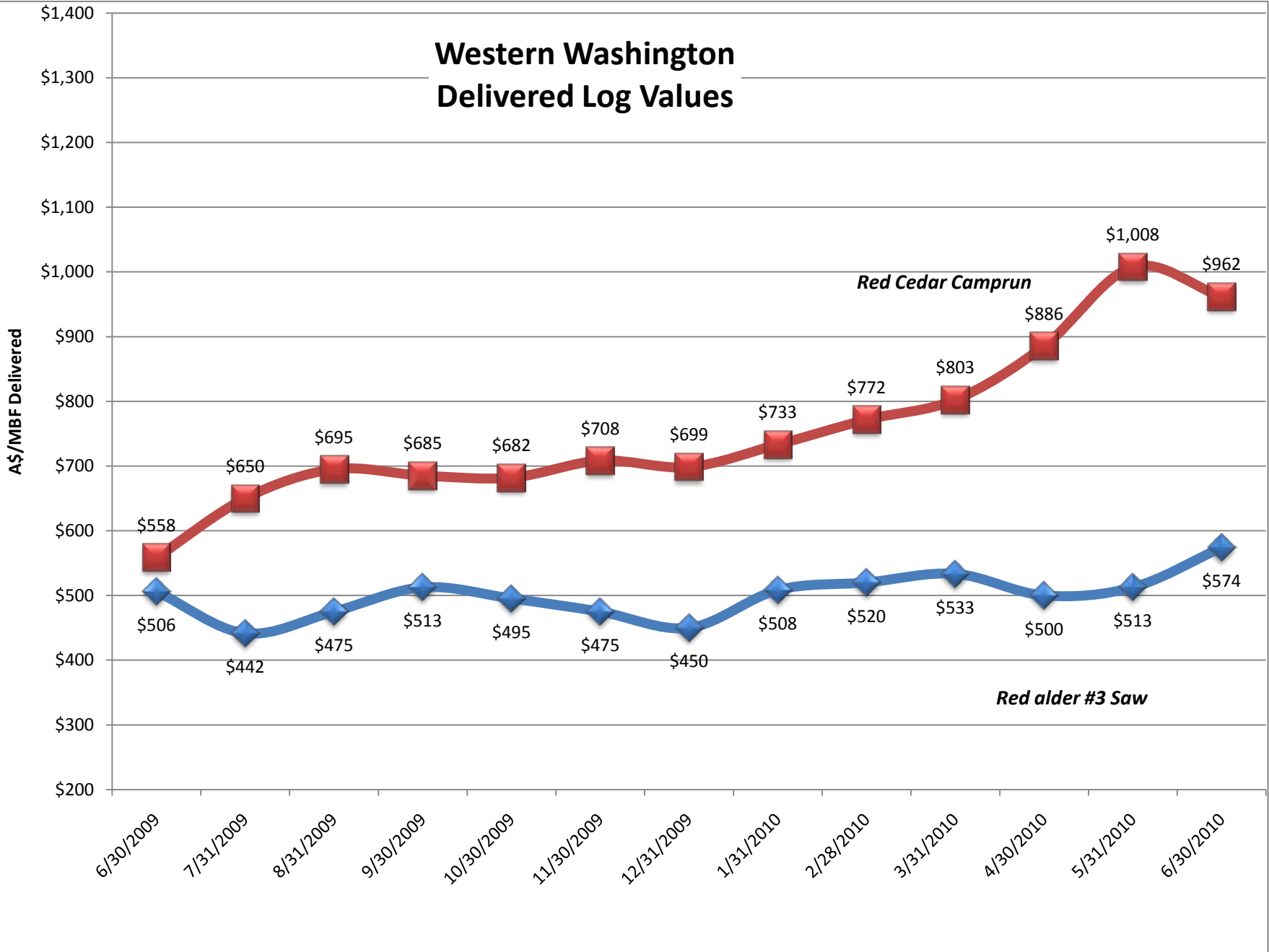
Puget Sound Region - Delivered Log Values

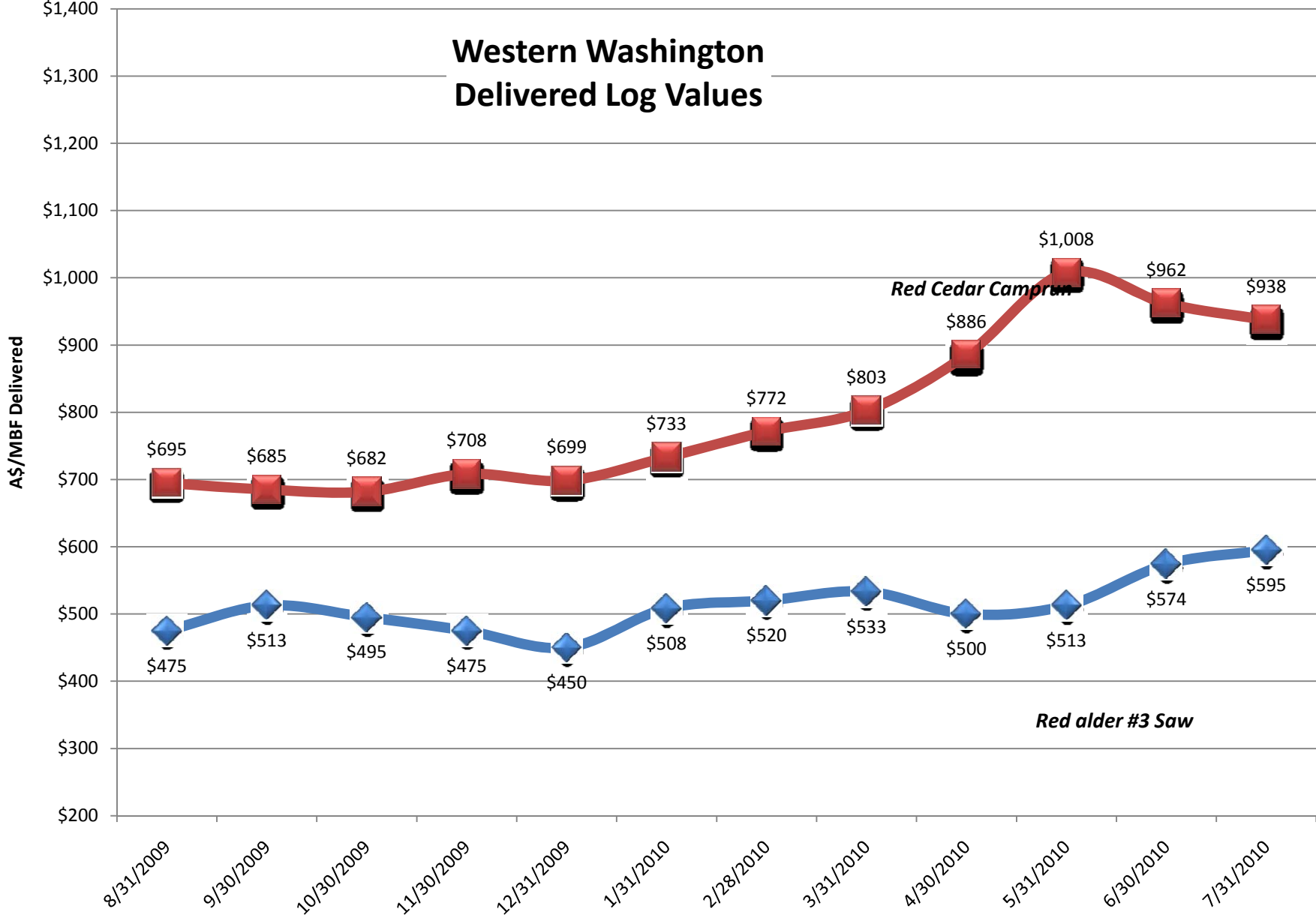

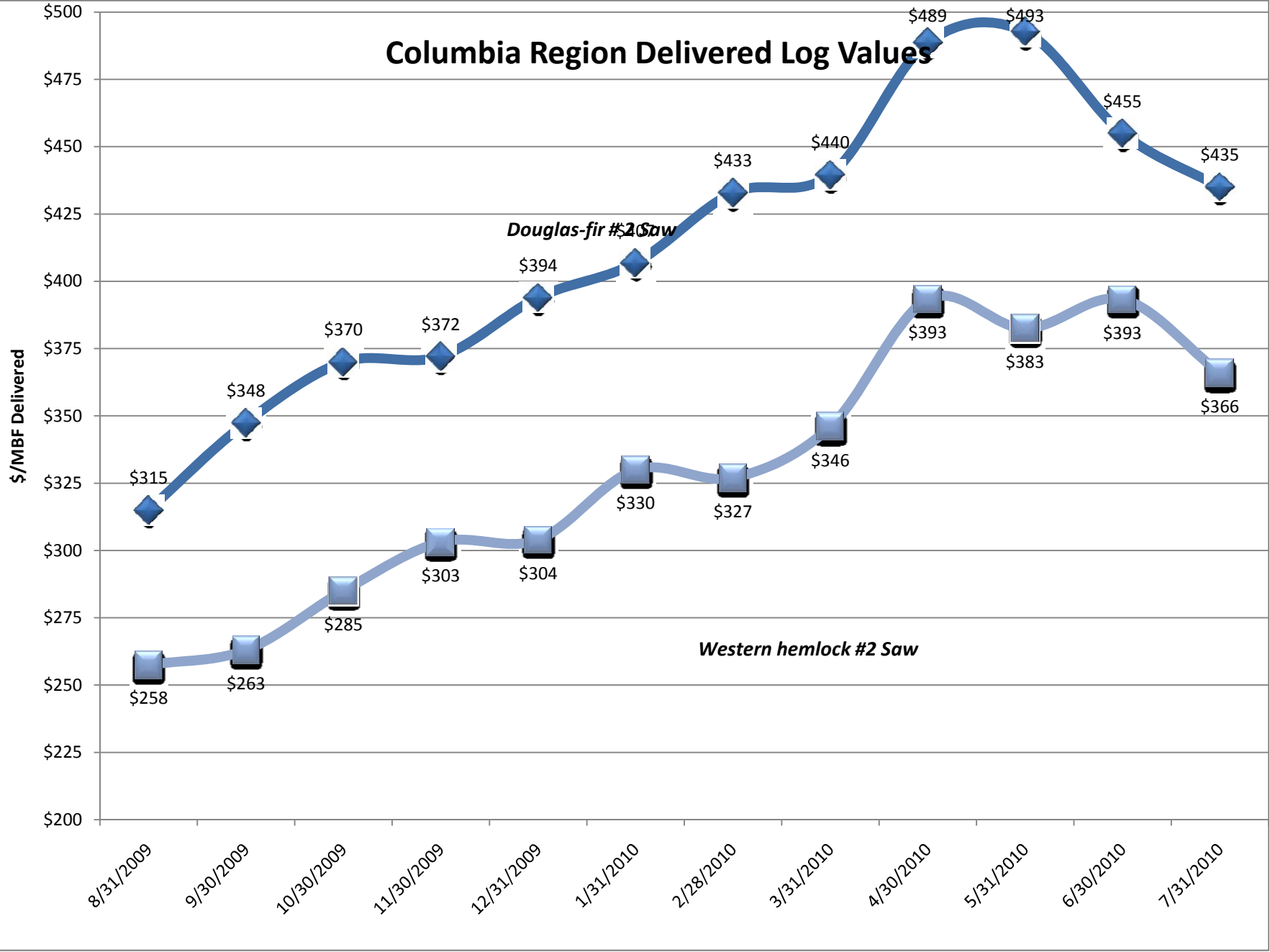

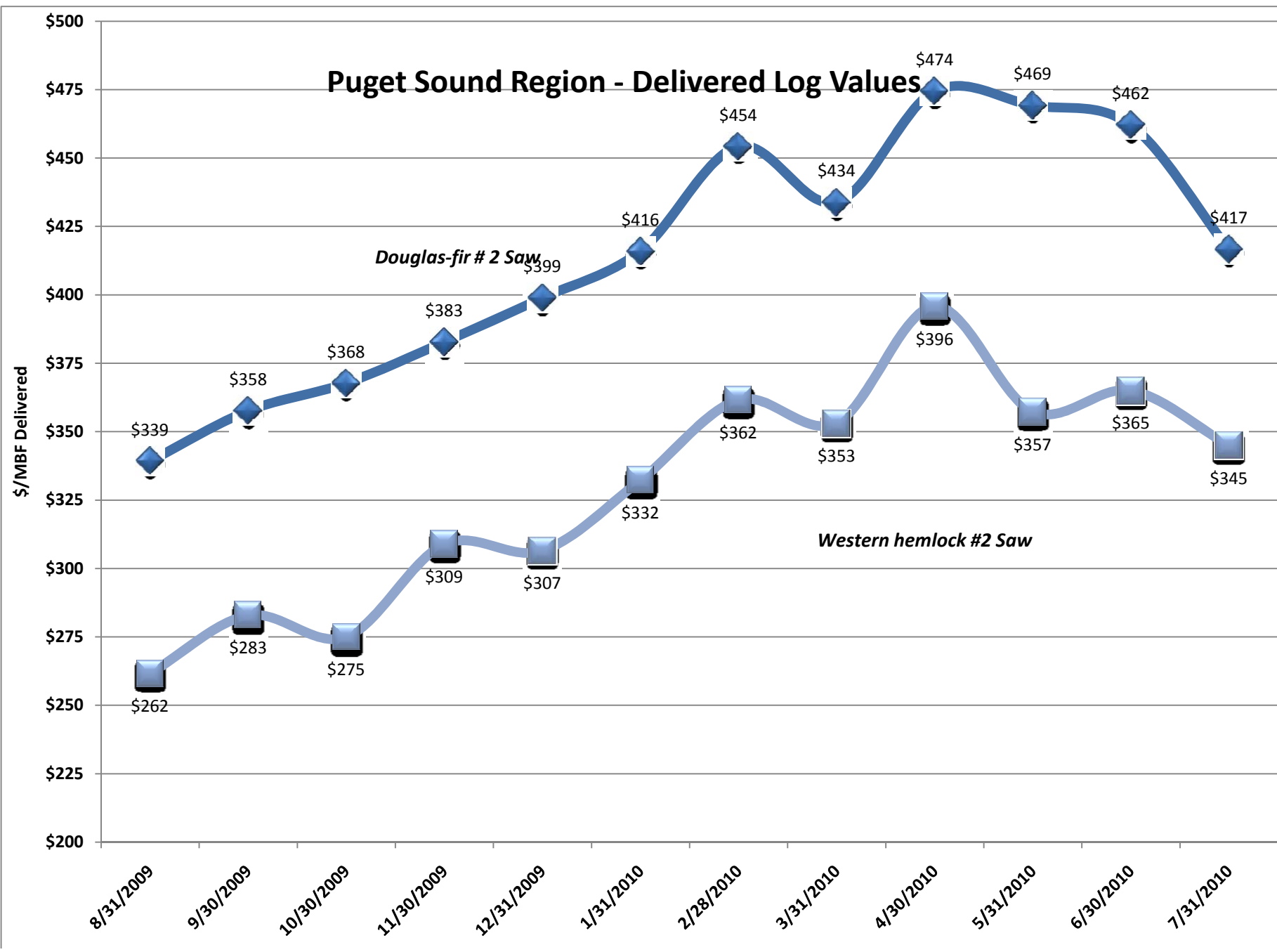
Western Washington Delivered Log Values

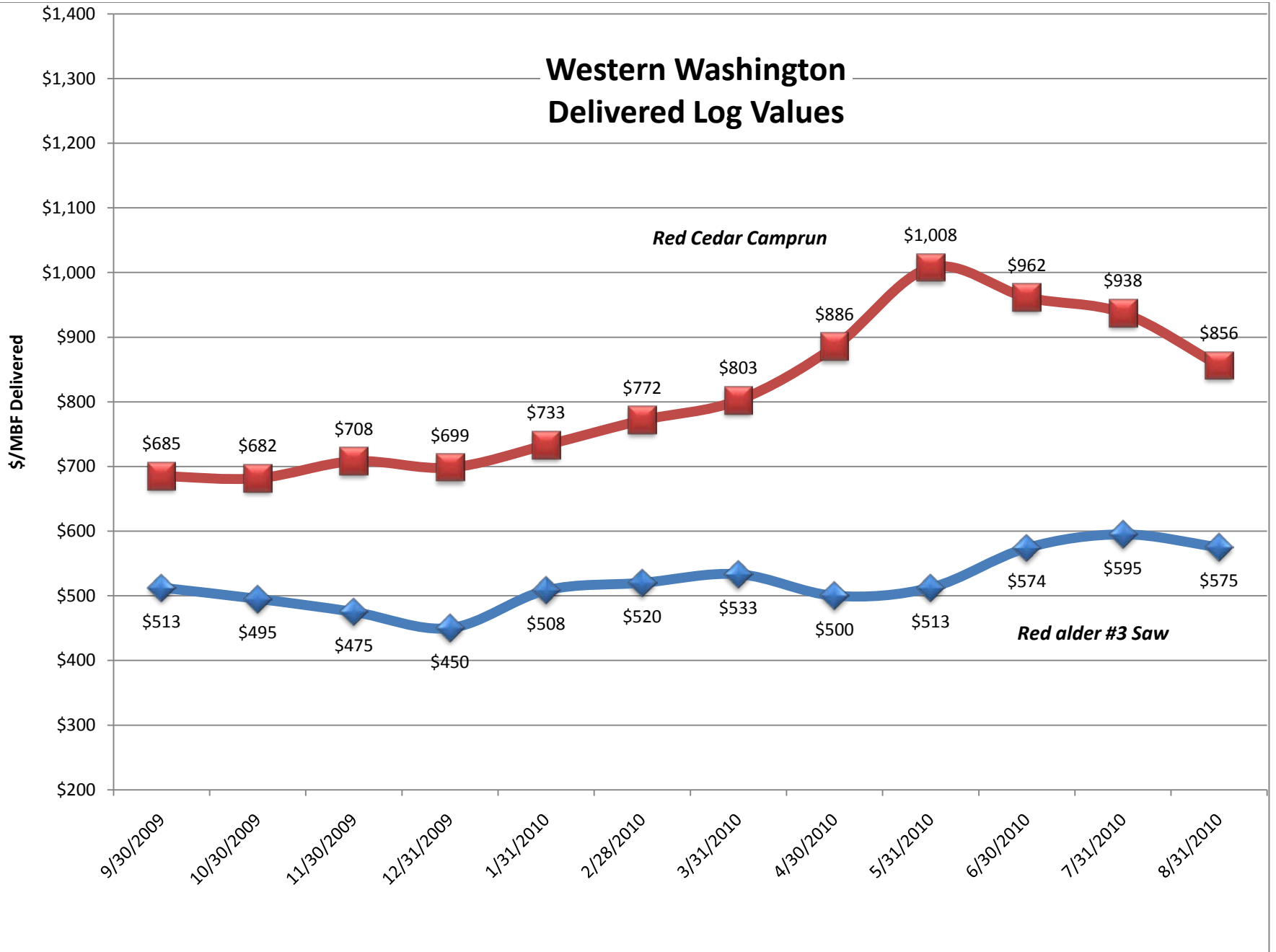
Puget Sound Region - Delivered Log Values

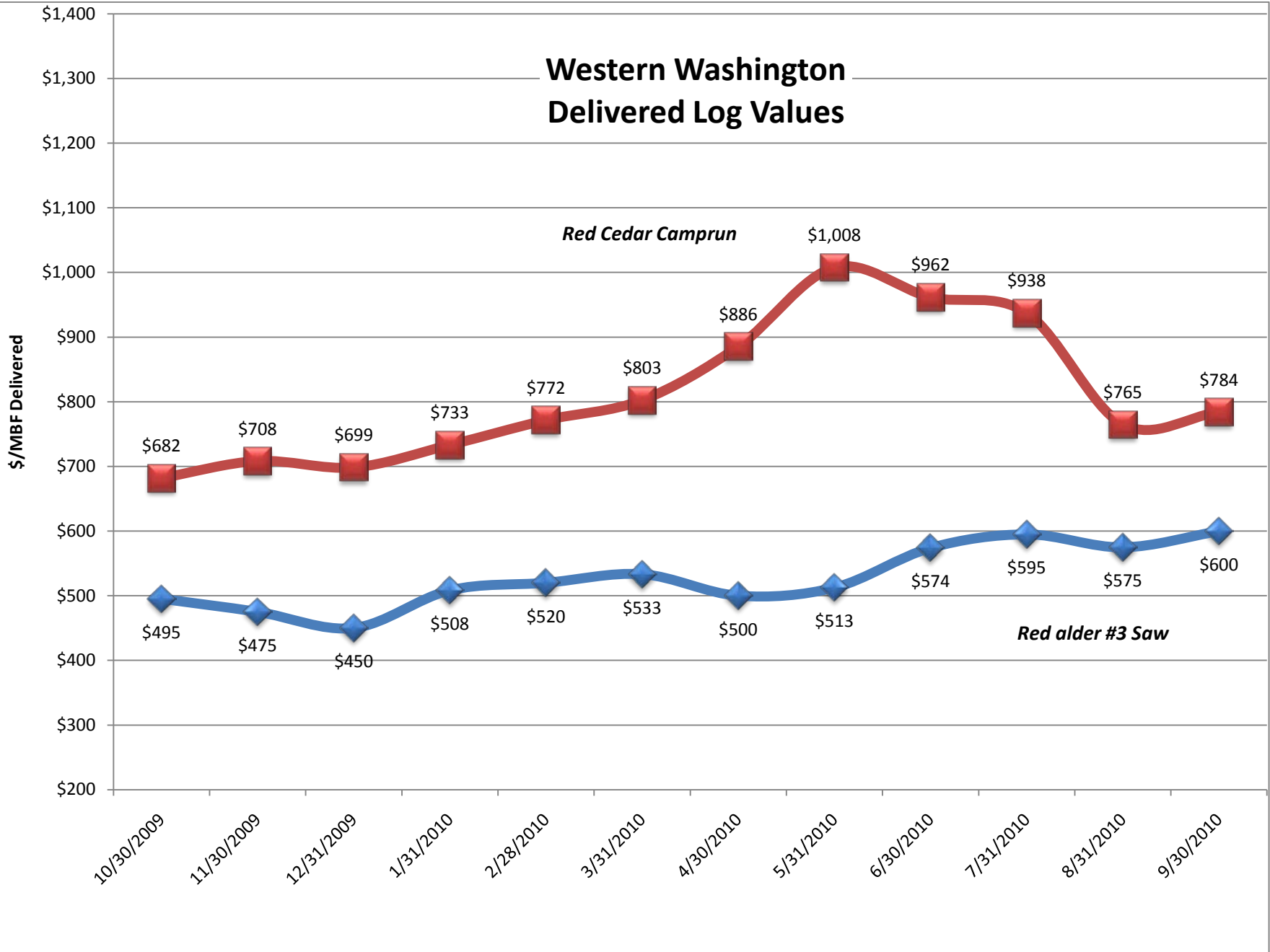
Puget Sound Region - Delivered Log Values
