Click on the individual layers to open a searchable table

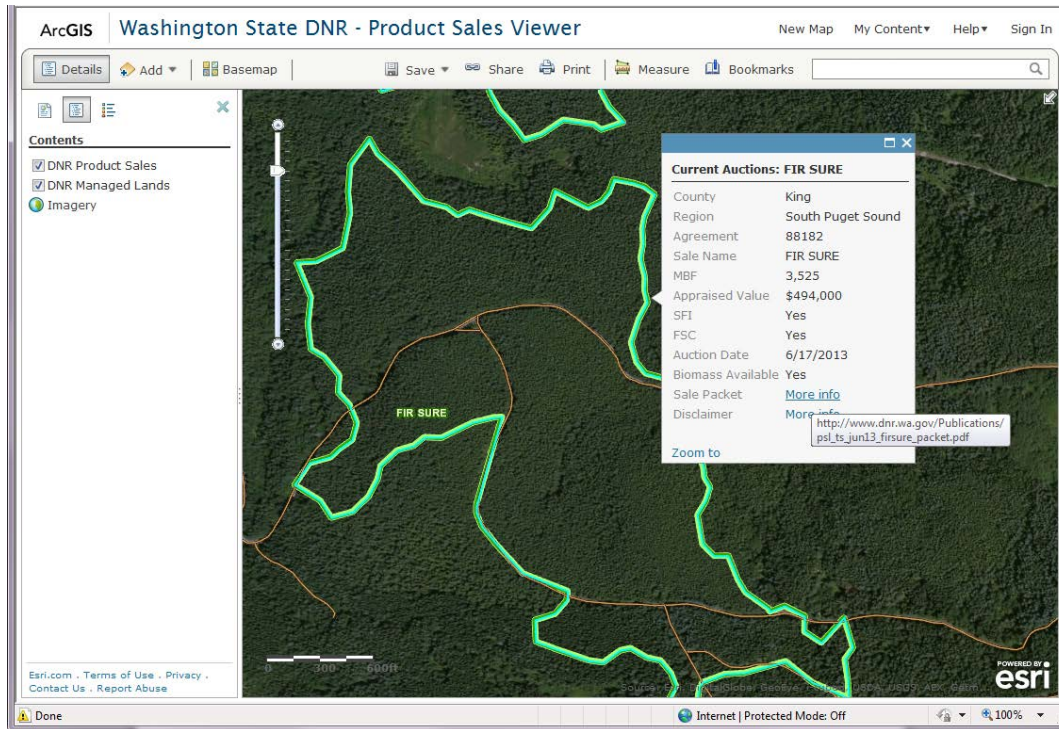
