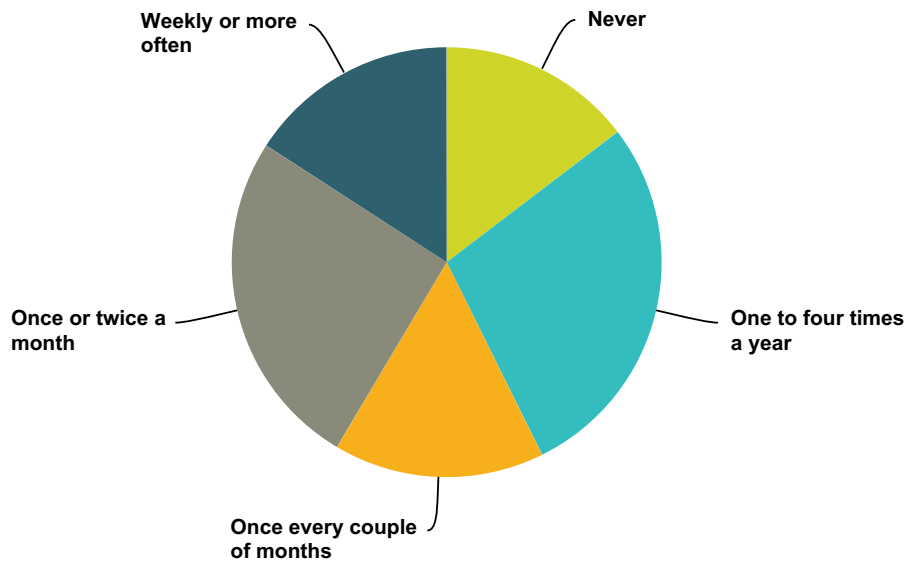


Q1 How often do you engage in recreational target shooting?

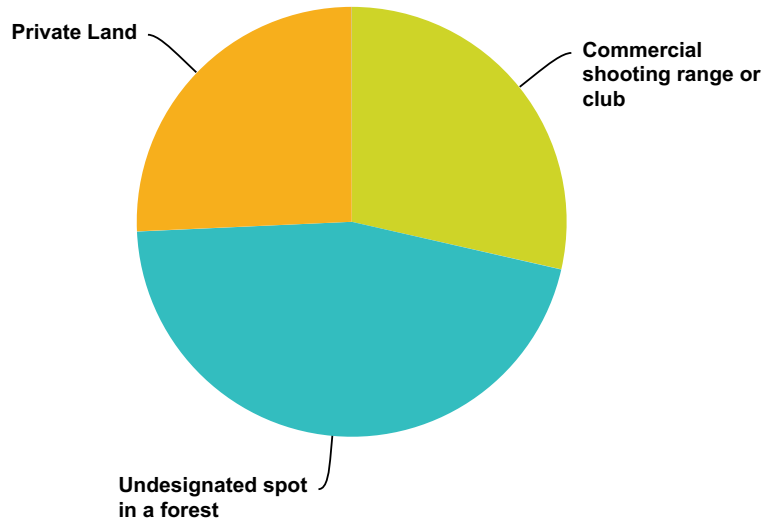

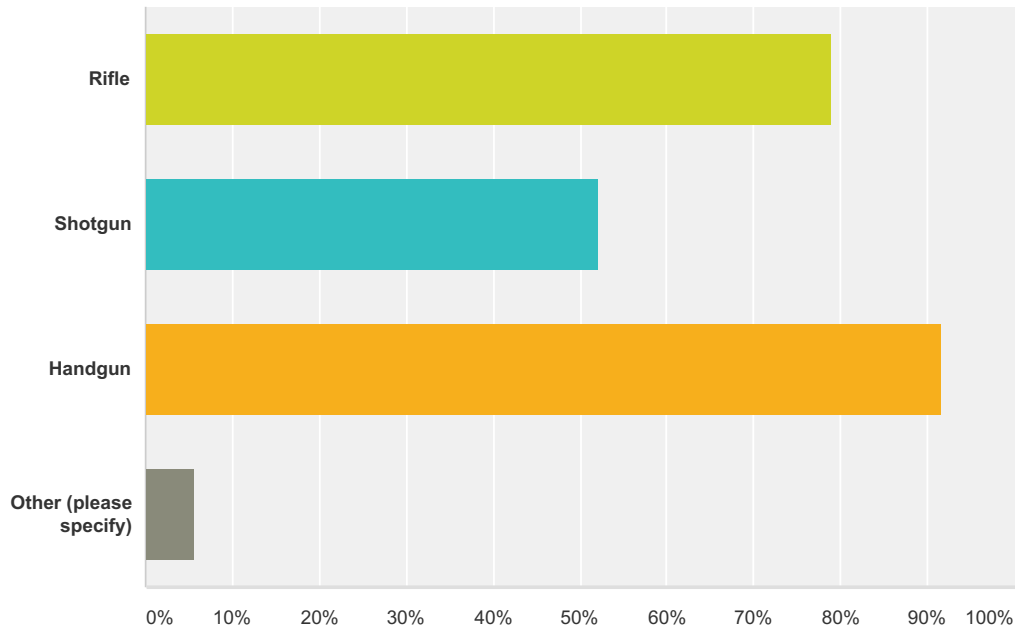

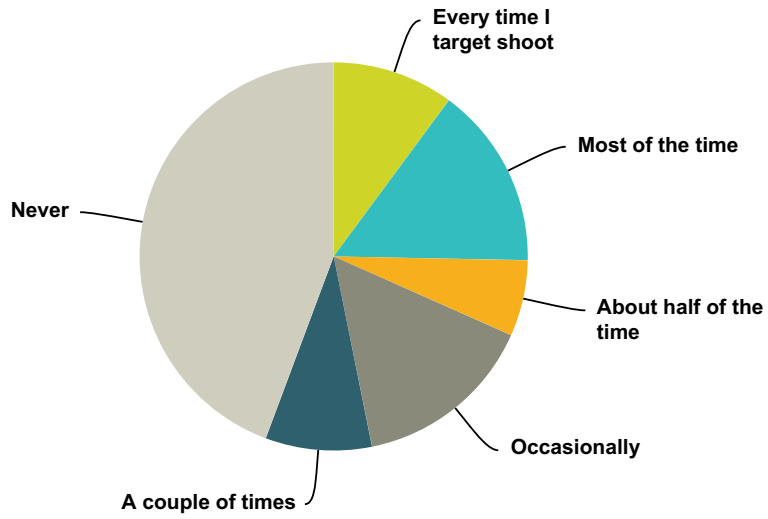

Q4 How often do you target shoot in the Tahuya State Forest?

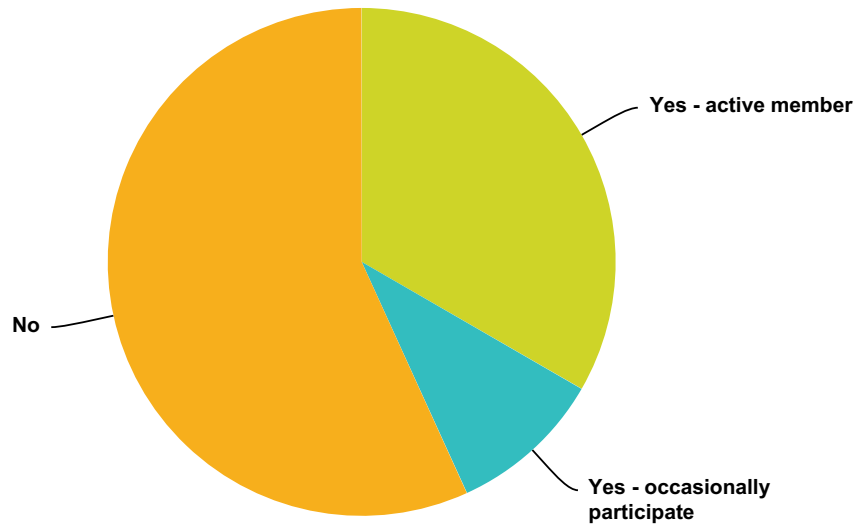

Q5 Do you belong to an organized recreational group or club?

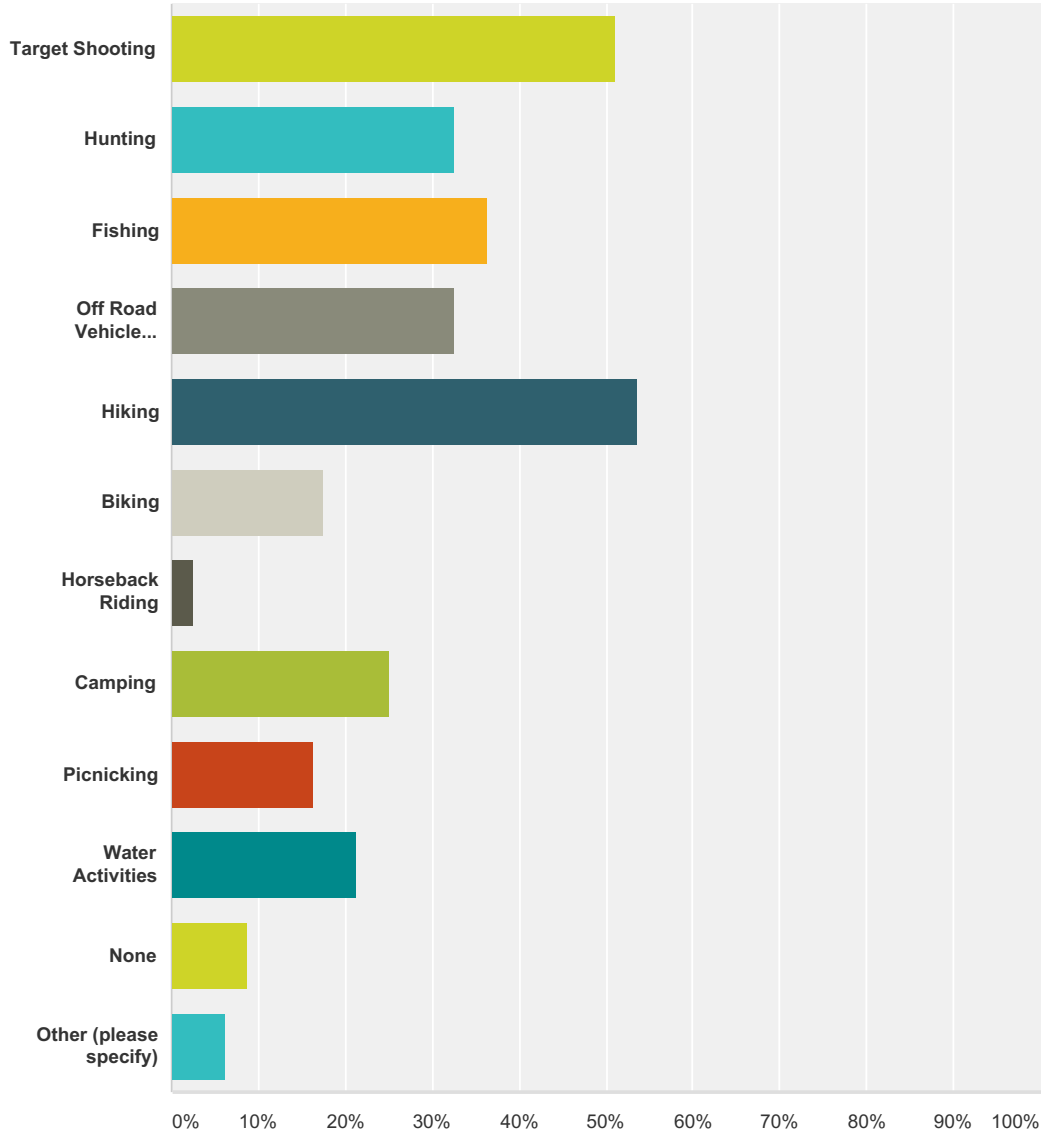

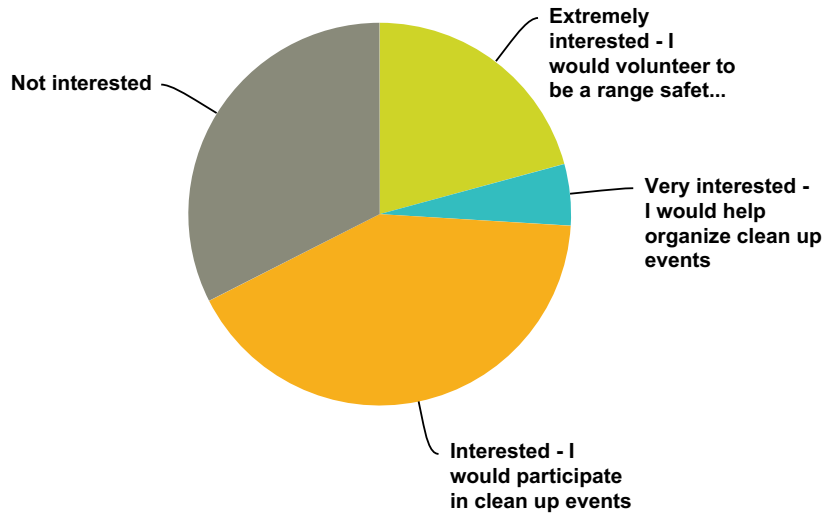

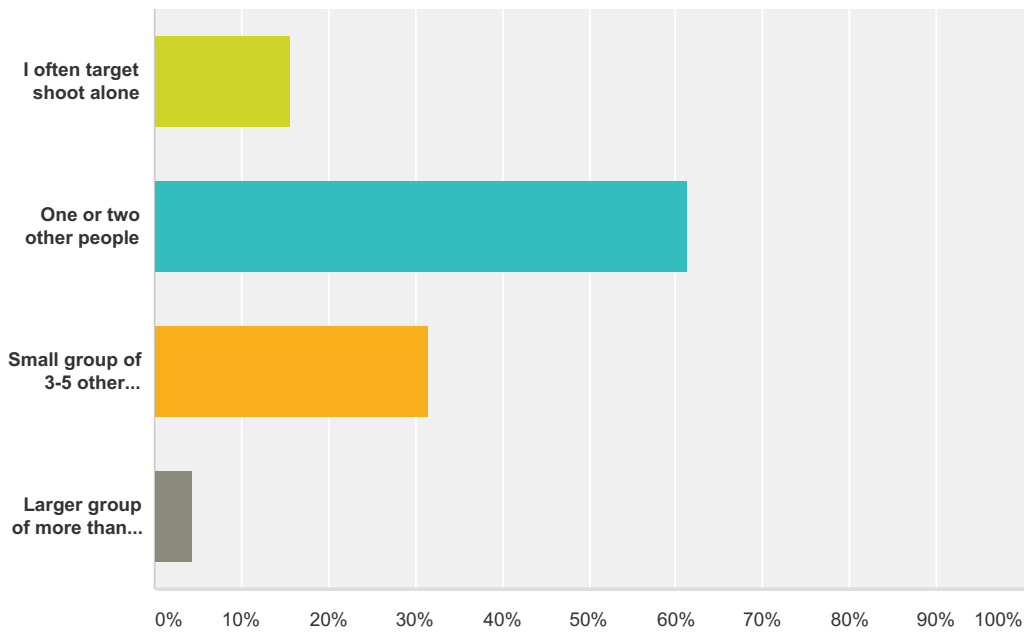

Q8 When you target shoot, what is the usual size of your group?

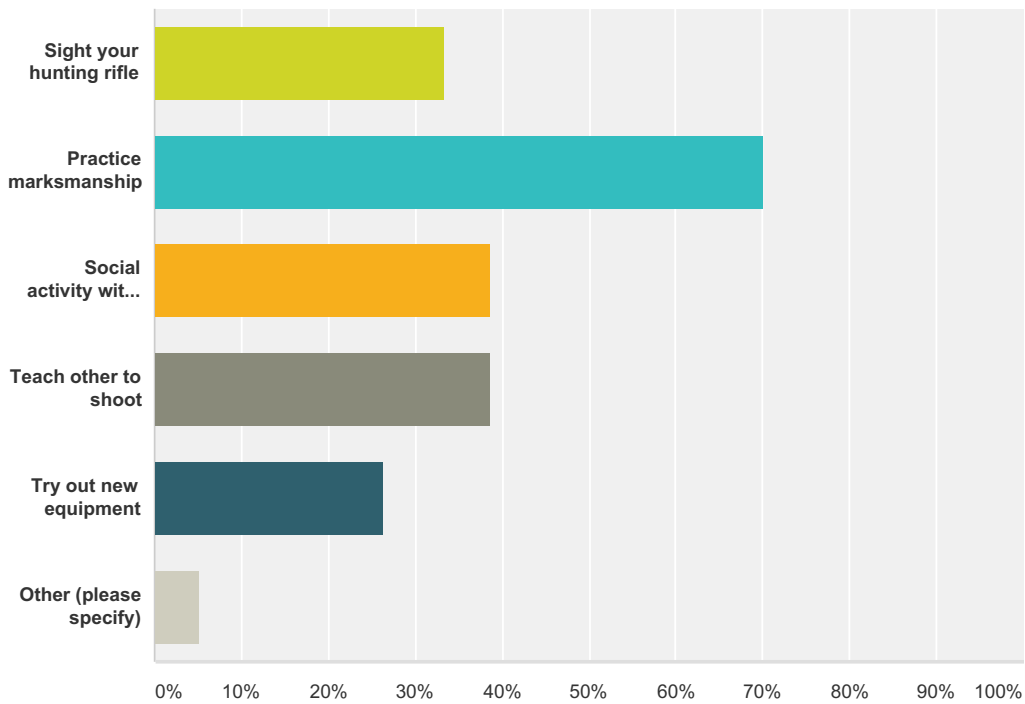

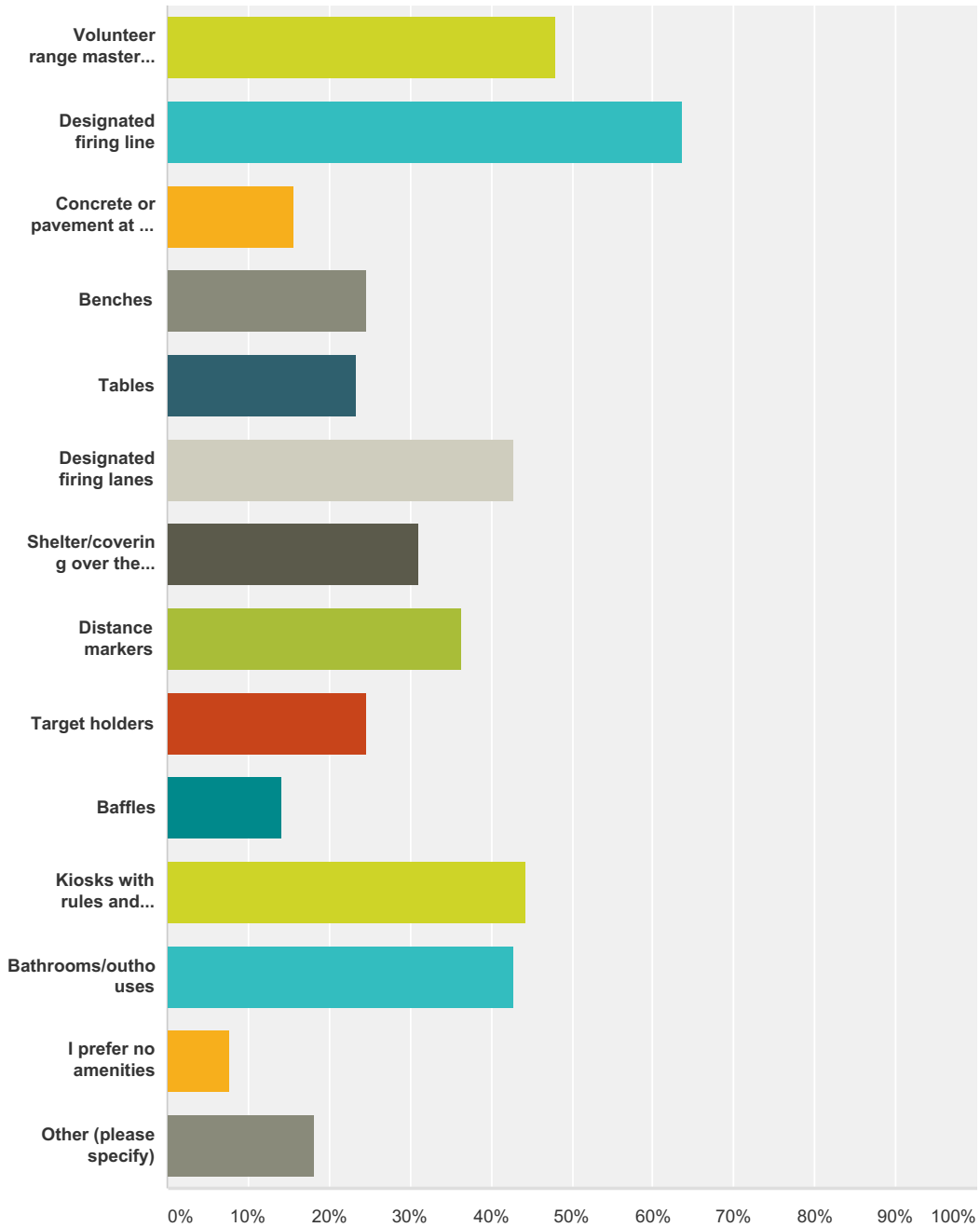

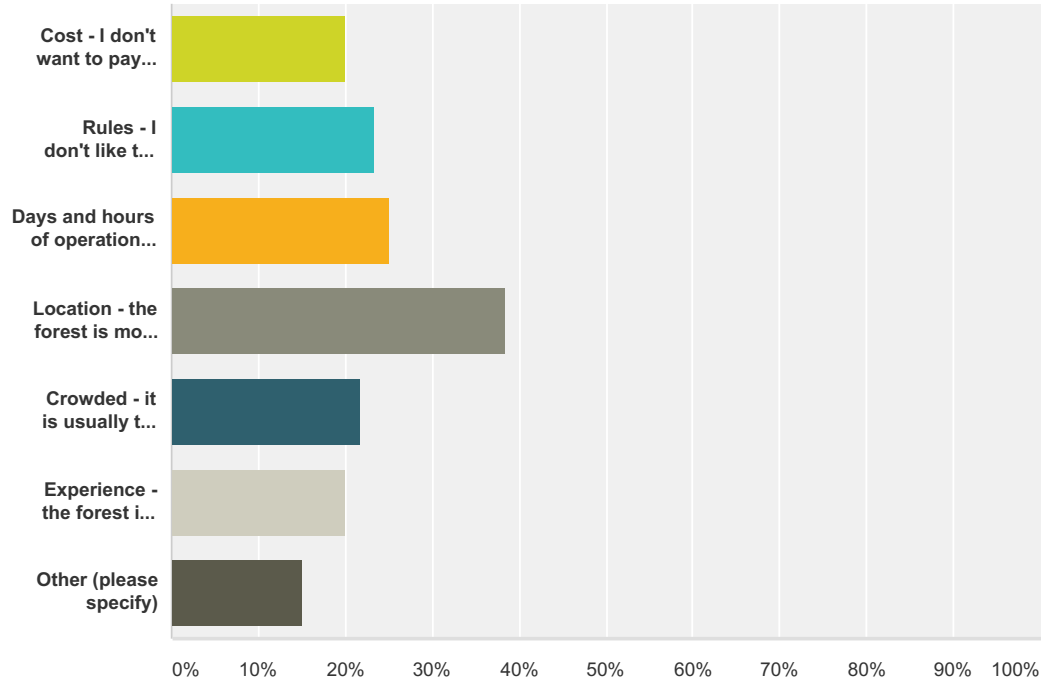

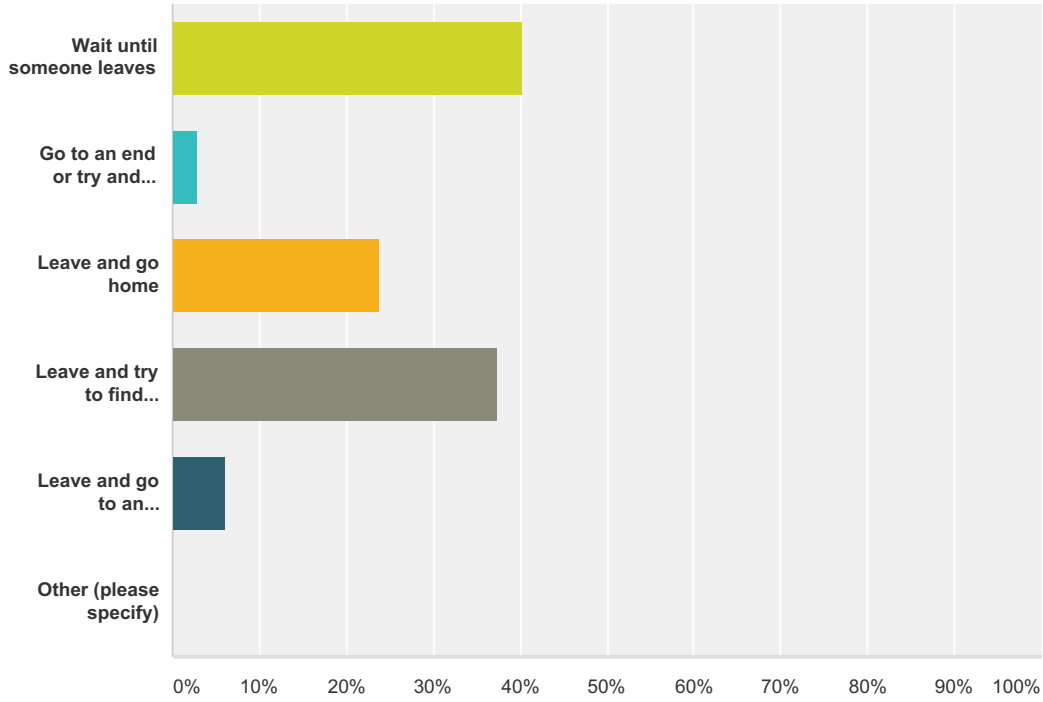

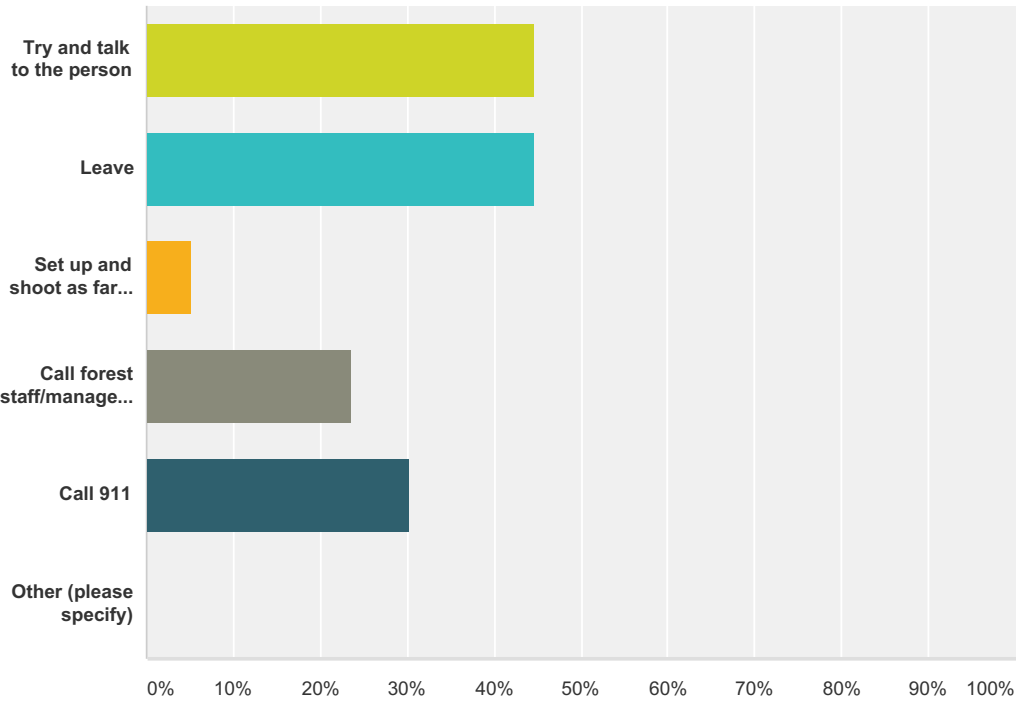

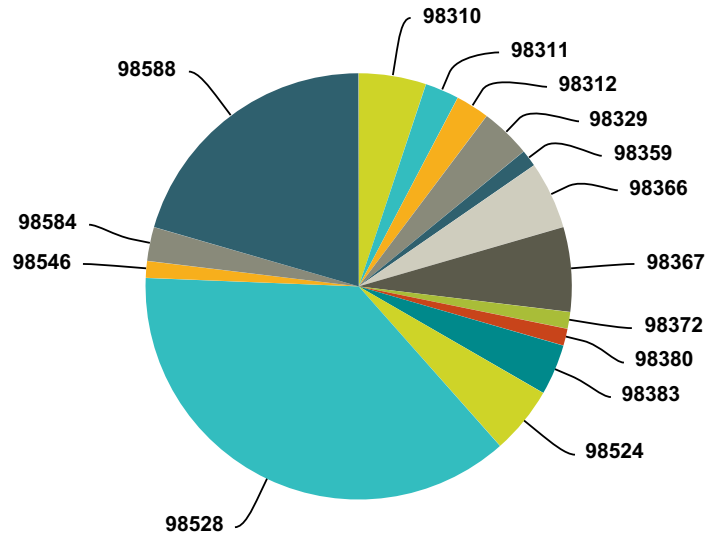
