



# TIMBER SALE MAP







From Forks, drive north on US 101 for 12 miles. After MP 203, turn right on Mary Clark Road. Continue 0.4 mi. to Unit 1, on right. To reach Unit 2, drive 500 feet past Unit 1 and turn right on the LTSP Main (gated, AA1 key). Continue another 500 feet and turn left on the Mary Clark Pit Access Road.
