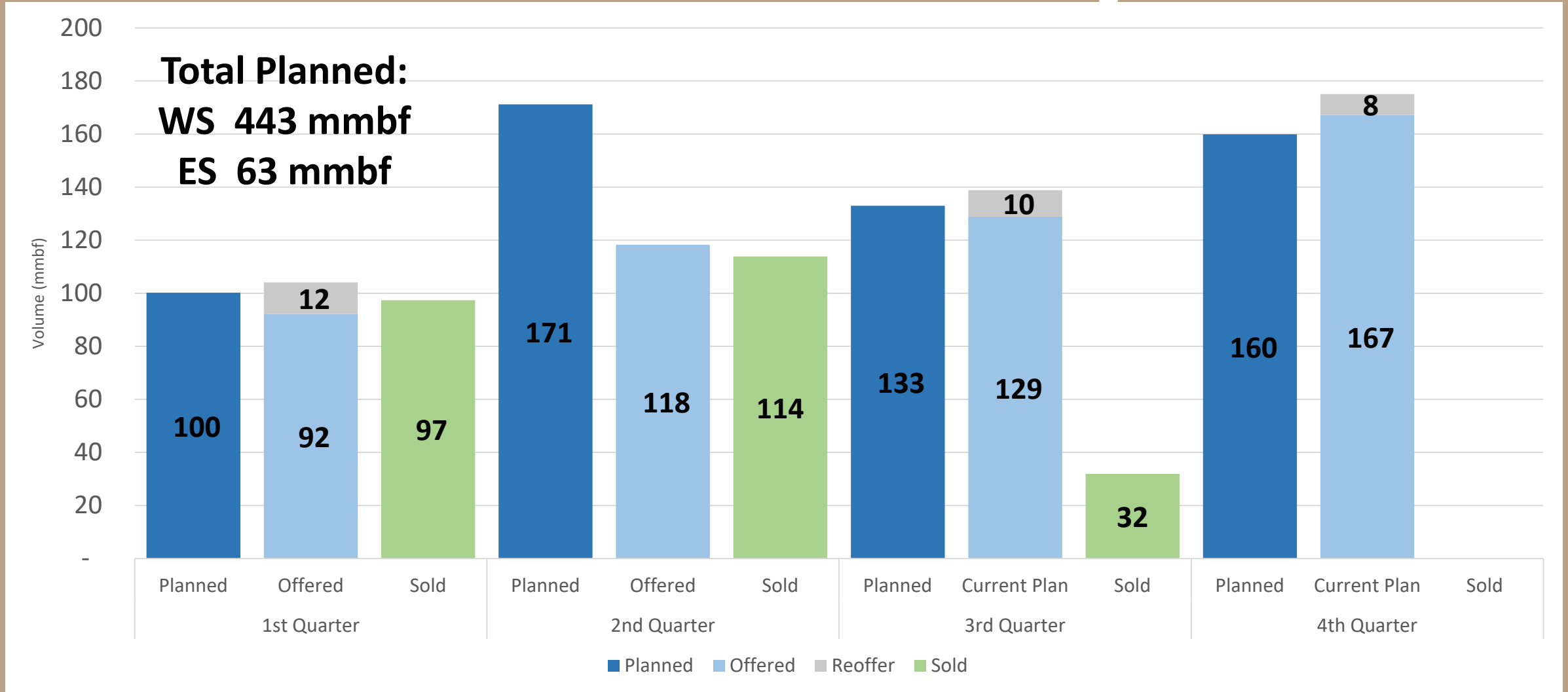

# Fiscal Year 2023 Update

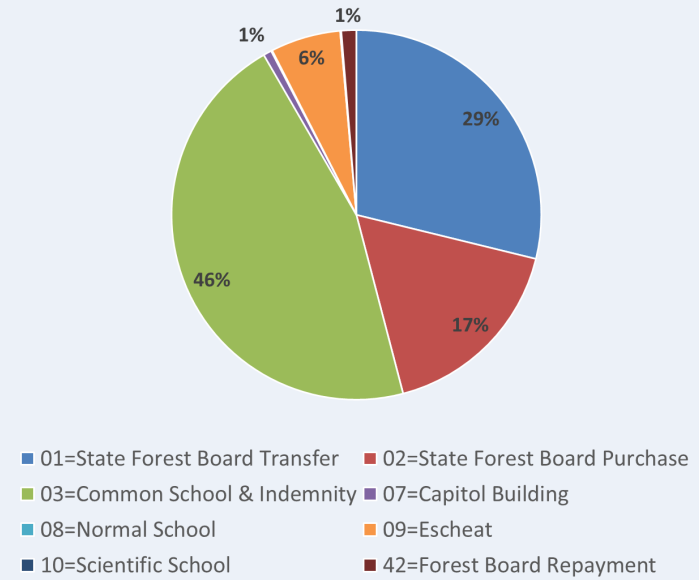

Appraised Revenue % by Trust



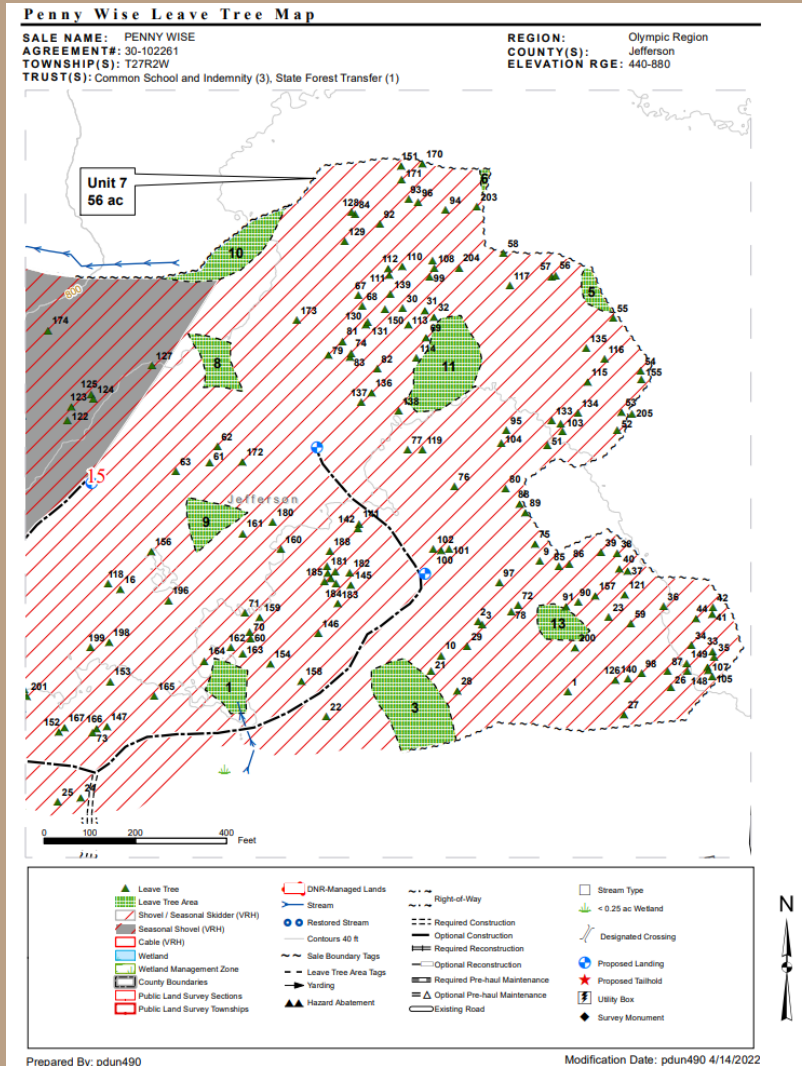

# Pennywise TS Update

- A comment was made at the Public Testimony segment of the January 17<sup>th</sup> BNR meeting regarding the harvest of designated leave trees from the Pennywise timber sale.
- DNR regional staff field responded to the comment on the afternoon of January 17<sup>th</sup> by conducting a field review of the timber sale and found the information cited in the testimony to be incorrect.
- During the sale layout process several trees marked with blue bands “leave trees” that were determined to be within the right-of-way boundary of a new road location. Substitute leave trees were selected to replace those that were located within the road location and the original blue-painted trees were covered with black paint utilizing the standards documented in procedure PR 14-006-093 TIMBER SALE MARKING AND PAINTING STANDARDS.
- The Forester, while conducting the pre-sale layout, documented the leave tree exchange by recording the changes in an excel spreadsheet and map where every leave tree is identified by size, species, and leave tree number.
- The terms and conditions of the Pennywise timber sale contract have been enforced and all of the retention trees have been fully documented and accounted for.
