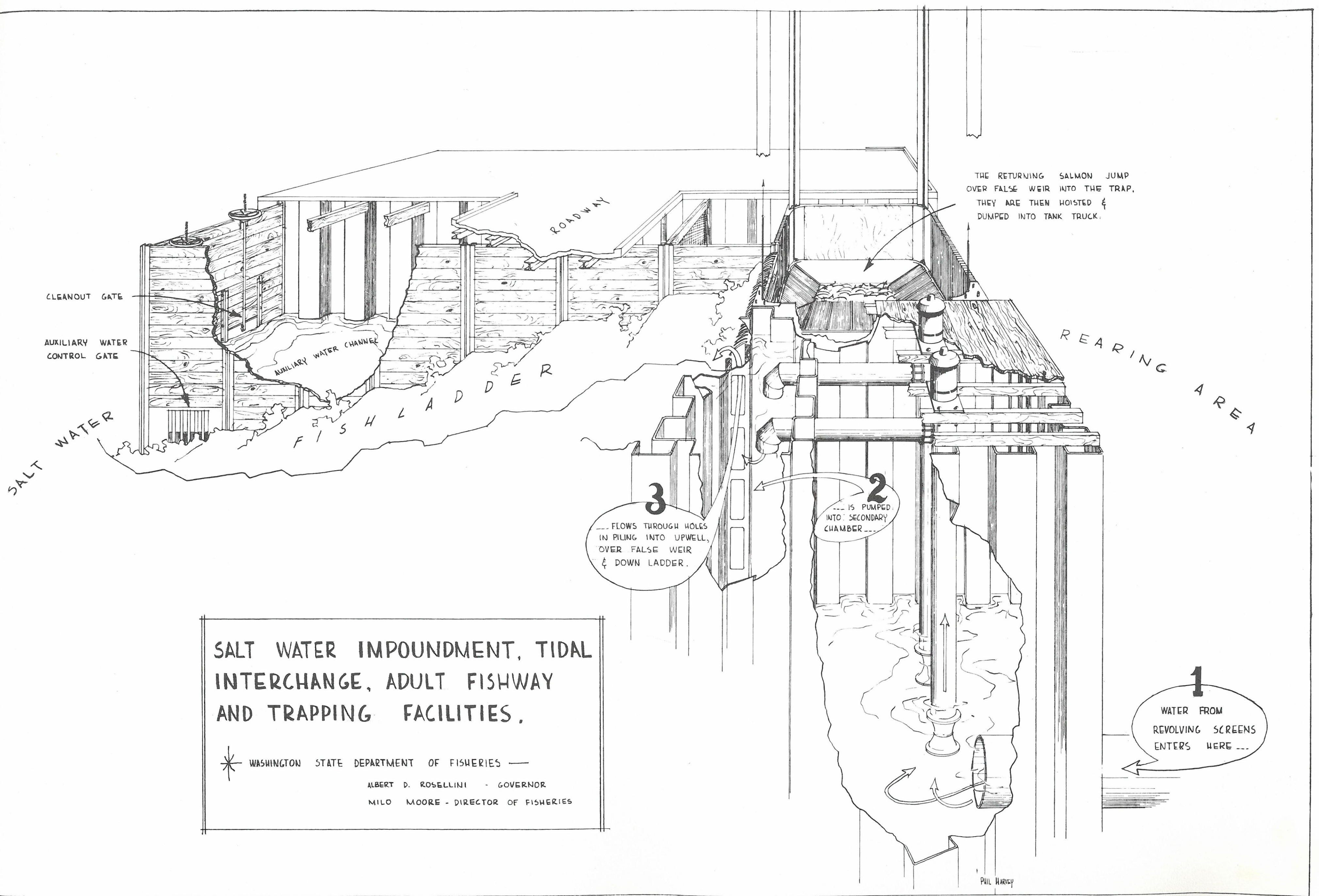

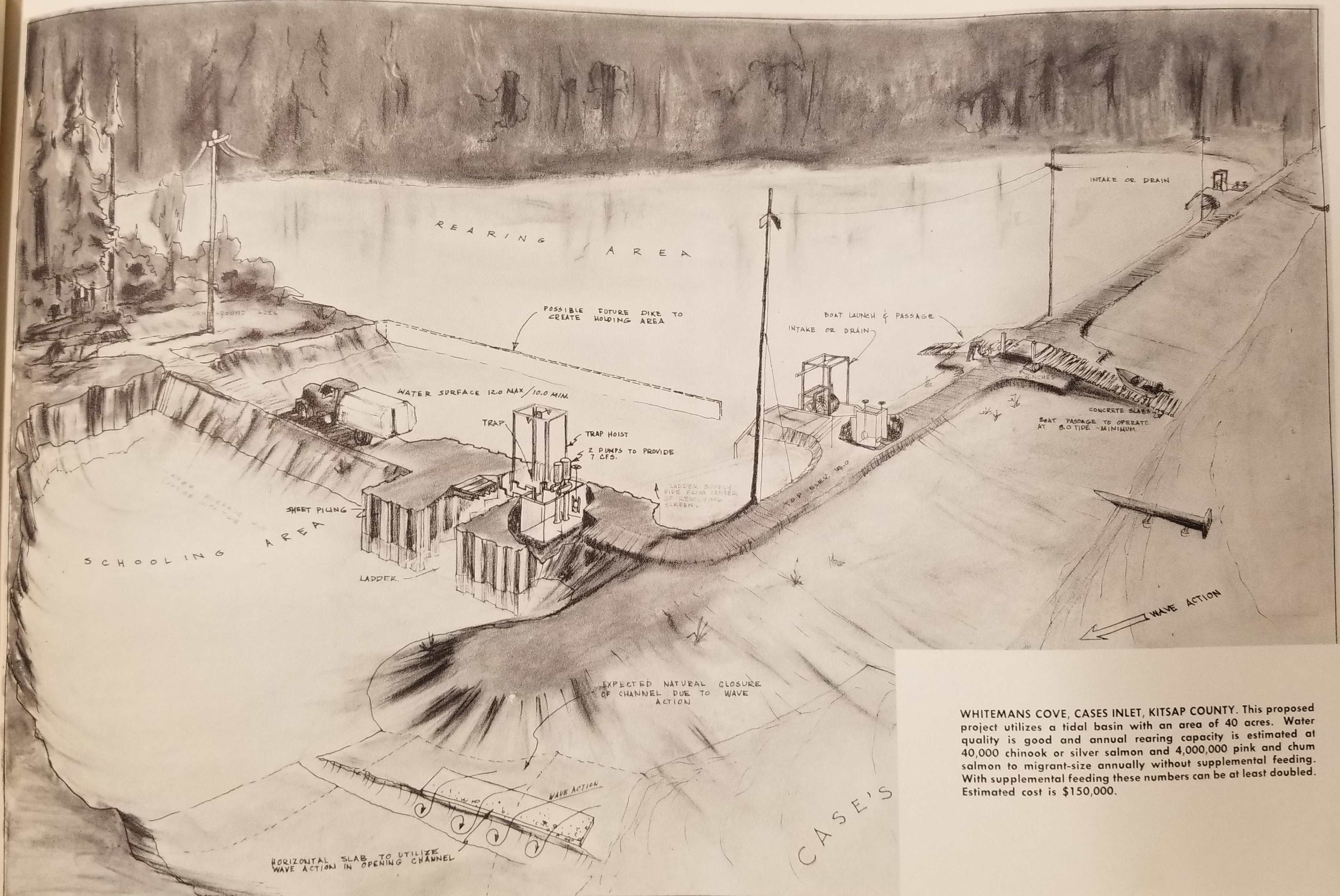

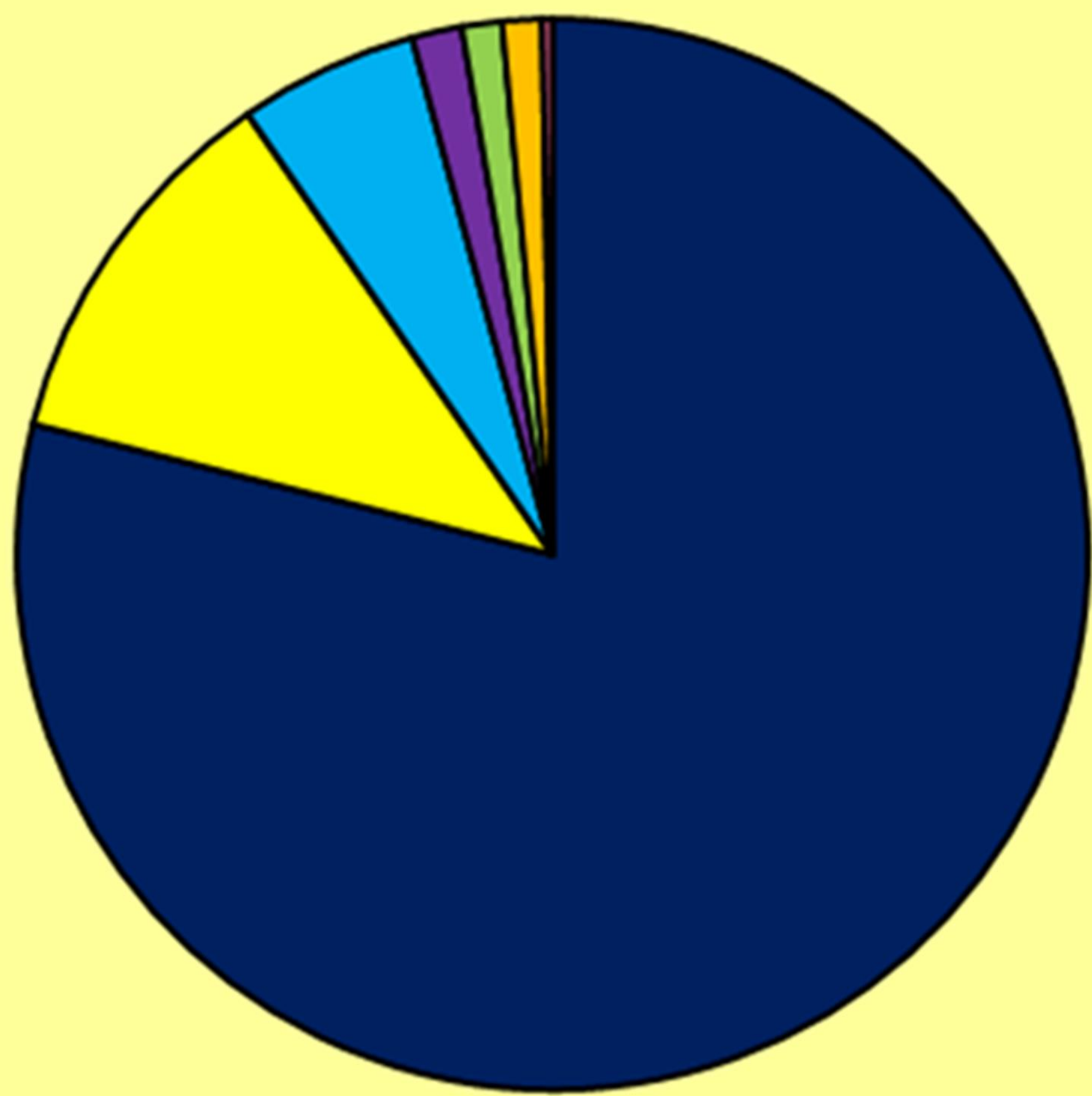

WHITEMANS COVE, CASES INLET, KITSAP COUNTY. This proposed project utilizes a tidal basin with an area of 40 acres. Water quality is good and annual rearing capacity is estimated at 40,000 chinook or silver salmon and 4,000,000 pink and chum salmon to migrant-size annually without supplemental feeding. With supplemental feeding these numbers can be at least doubled. Estimated cost is \$150,000.
