# Education & Enforcement

## Rules

*For your safety and enjoyment, know the rules and follow them.*

Motorized vehicles allowed only on roads marked with a Green Dot.

Limit camping stay to 10 days on DNR lands within a 30-day period.

**ROAD MANAGEMENT AREA**

To report an emergency or fire, call 911

If a trail is not posted with DNR signs, and does not appear on DNR maps, it is not approved for public use.

Violators are subject to civil or criminal prosecution under WAC 332.52, and other applicable law.

To volunteer, call, 509-925-8510

GREEN DOT ROAD

100 ft. or less

No vehicle camping or parking more than 100 ft. from a Green Dot road.

Vehicle access to campsites further than 100' off a Green Dot Road will be designated with a white post with the words "Camping Spur."

No removal of wood from state land without landowner permit.

No fireworks or fire-causing devices.

**FIRES?**  
SEE DISPERSED CAMPFIRE RULES SIGN

Propane-powered campfire permissible year-round.

No permanent structures allowed.

No removal of minerals or artifacts without landowner permit.

Do not cut trees or snags. Down wood less than 12" diameter may be collected for on-site camp wood.
