Description:

Washington State Department of Natural Resources will begin implementing the Quartermaster Harbor Mooring Buoy Management Plan (QHMP) on February 23, 2015, which is thirty (30) days from the date of this notification.

The QHMP is a supplement to the Maury Island Environmental Aquatic Reserve Management Plan, adopted on October 29, 2004. The QHMP was publicly announced on April 3, 2013. The goal of the QHMP is to safely, sustainably, and legally improve moorage opportunities while protecting the interests of local recreational boaters and waterfront residents.

On and after February 23, 2015, Washington State Department of Natural Resources intends to authorize up to 54 mooring buoy licenses on State-owned aquatic lands, for the sole purpose of recreational-use mooring buoys. They are located in Burton Cove, in King County, Washington.
