

LAKE CUSHMAN INTER-TRUST EXCHANGE 2015-2017

PROPOSAL

The Department of Natural Resources proposes to exchange 70.21 acres, more or less, of Charitable, Educational, Penal and Reformatory Institutions (CEP&RI) Trust property in Mason County for 77.20 acres, more or less, of Common School Trust property in Thurston County.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the exchange is to designate the CEP&RI Trust land as Common School Trust so that the newly designated Common School Trust land can be included in a proposal to be transferred to the City of Tacoma, Department of Public Utilities, Light Division.

BENEFITS

- Common School Trust is repositioned for direct transfer at market value.
- CEP&RI Trust land is repositioned to land that can be managed for timber revenue.
- Facilitates the direct transfer of property as authorized by Trust Land Transfer Legislation.

PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing was held in Tumwater on February 10, 2016. A summary of the testimony will be presented to the Board of Natural Resources.

GENERAL LOCATION

The CEP&RI Trust property is approximately eight air miles northwest of Hoodsport and is within Section 7, Township 23 North, Range 4 West, W.M., in South Puget Sound Region.

The Common School Trust property is approximately 10 miles west of Tumwater and is within Section 2, Township 17 North, Range 4 West, W.M., in South Puget Sound Region.

Mineral Rights are not included in the exchange and will be retained by their existing trust ownerships where owned. CEP&RI Trust does not own the mineral rights in Section 2.







RESOLUTION NO. 1481

A **RESOLUTION** relating to the exchange of real property, known as the Lake Cushman Inter-Trust Exchange transaction, and the reclassification of Charitable, Educational, Penal and Reformatory Institutions (CEP&RI) Trust property to Common School Trust property as authorized by RCW 79.17.010-.070 under Department of Natural Resources Exchange File No. 86-093099.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF NATURAL RESOURCES, DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, STATE OF WASHINGTON, THAT:

SECTION 1. The State of Washington, Department of Natural Resources, has title to and holds in trust under the provisions of Title 79 RCW the CEP&RI Trust property described in Exhibit A attached hereto which by this reference is made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The State of Washington, Department of Natural Resources, has title to and holds in trust under the provisions of 79 RCW the Common School Trust property described in Exhibit B attached hereto which by this reference is made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. The Board of Natural Resources finds that the exchange of the CEP&RI Trust property described in Exhibit A for the Common School Trust property described in Exhibit B is authorized by RCW 79.17.010-.070 and will result in the consolidation and blocking up of State lands and CEP&RI Trust will facilitate the management thereof, and the marketing of forest products therefrom.

The Board also finds that the real property described in Exhibit A is equal in value to the real property described in Exhibit B. The Board further finds that this exchange is in the best interest of the trusts for which the land is held.

SECTION 4. The Commissioner of Public Lands is authorized to execute such agreements, writings, and relinquishments as are necessary or proper to complete an exchange of the above referenced property.

SECTION 5. Should the Exchange authorized by this resolution be consummated, the State of Washington, Department of Natural Resources, shall:

A. Transfer the real property described in Exhibit A to the status of Common School Trust property to be administered and provided for under the laws of the State of Washington;

- B. Transfer the real property described in Exhibit B to the status of CEP&RI Trust property to be held and administered as provided for under the laws of the State of Washington.
- C. All oils, gases, coals, ores, minerals and fossils, are not included in this exchange and will be retained by their existing trust ownerships, as provided under RCW 79.11.210.
