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REQUIREMENTS & CONDITIONS

- ❖ LIMIT 6 CORDS ANNUALLY
- ❖ First Come, First Serve Basis.
- ❖ For personal use only.
- ❖ NO RESALE.
- ❖ NO CEDAR MAY BE CUT OR REMOVED.
- ❖ Vehicles must stay on the Roads – DO NOT block roads.
- ❖ Keep all ditches, roads & landing free of debris.
- ❖ Be careful of newly planted seedlings.
- ❖ No cutting live trees, standing snags, or blue painted trees.
- ❖ Mechanical yarding NOT permitted.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS FOR FIRE SEASON

(April 15 to October 15)

Power saw operators must have a:

- ❖ Shovel and fire extinguisher on-site AND an approved spark arrester on ALL chain saws.
- ❖ Cutting allowed on PRECAUTION LEVEL 1 days only.
- ❖ Fire extinguisher must be minimum 2 1/2 pounds.
- ❖ A fire watch is required for one hour following shut-down of chain saws.
- ❖ Call 1-800-527-3305 or for fire Season information.

NO TREES MARKED WITH PAINT, (WHETHER STANDING OR DOWN), SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE FIREWOOD AREA. NO FIREWOOD CUTTING WILL BE ALLOWED INSIDE ANY MARKED OR TAGGED LEAVE TREE CLUMPS.

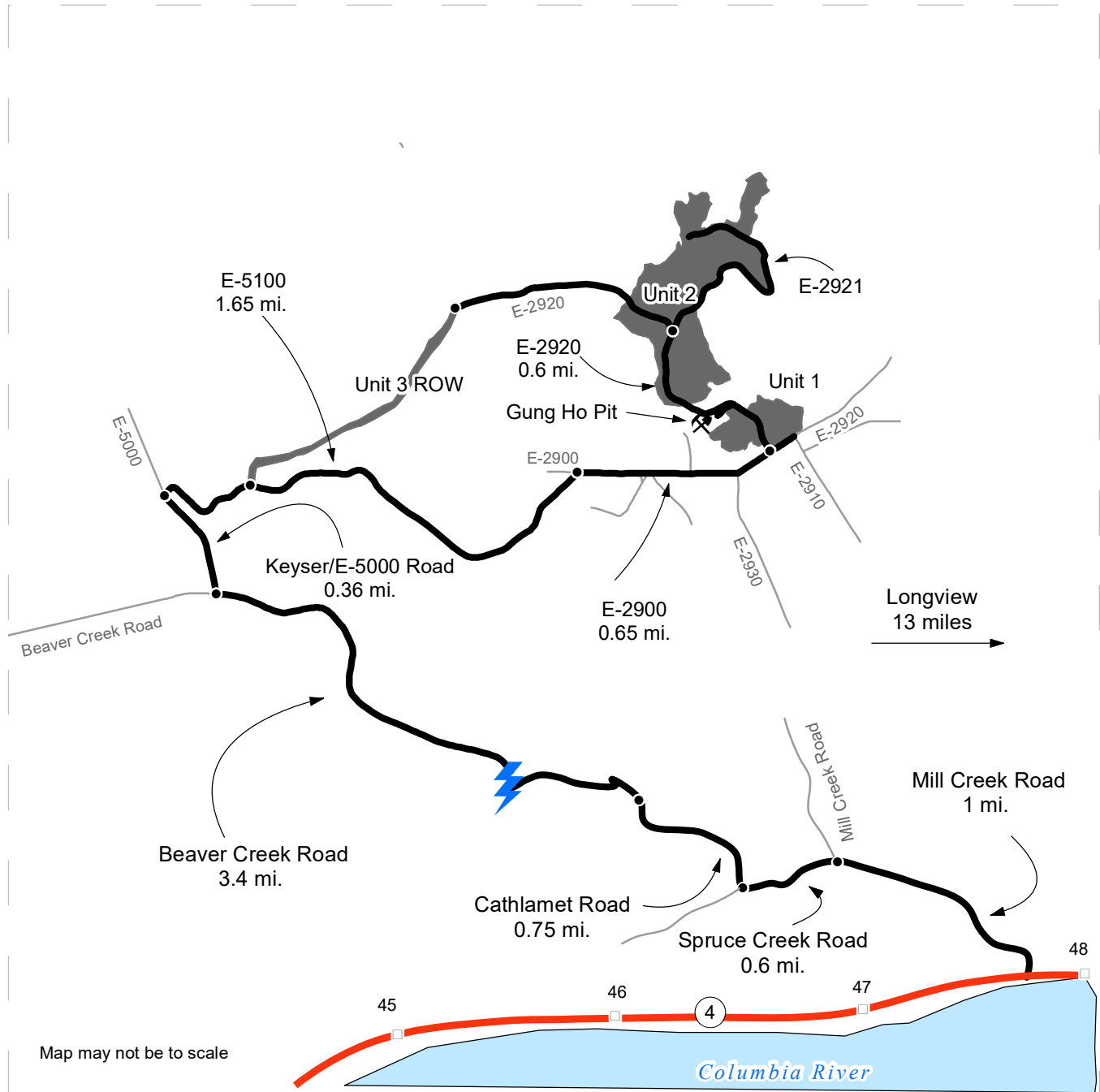

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

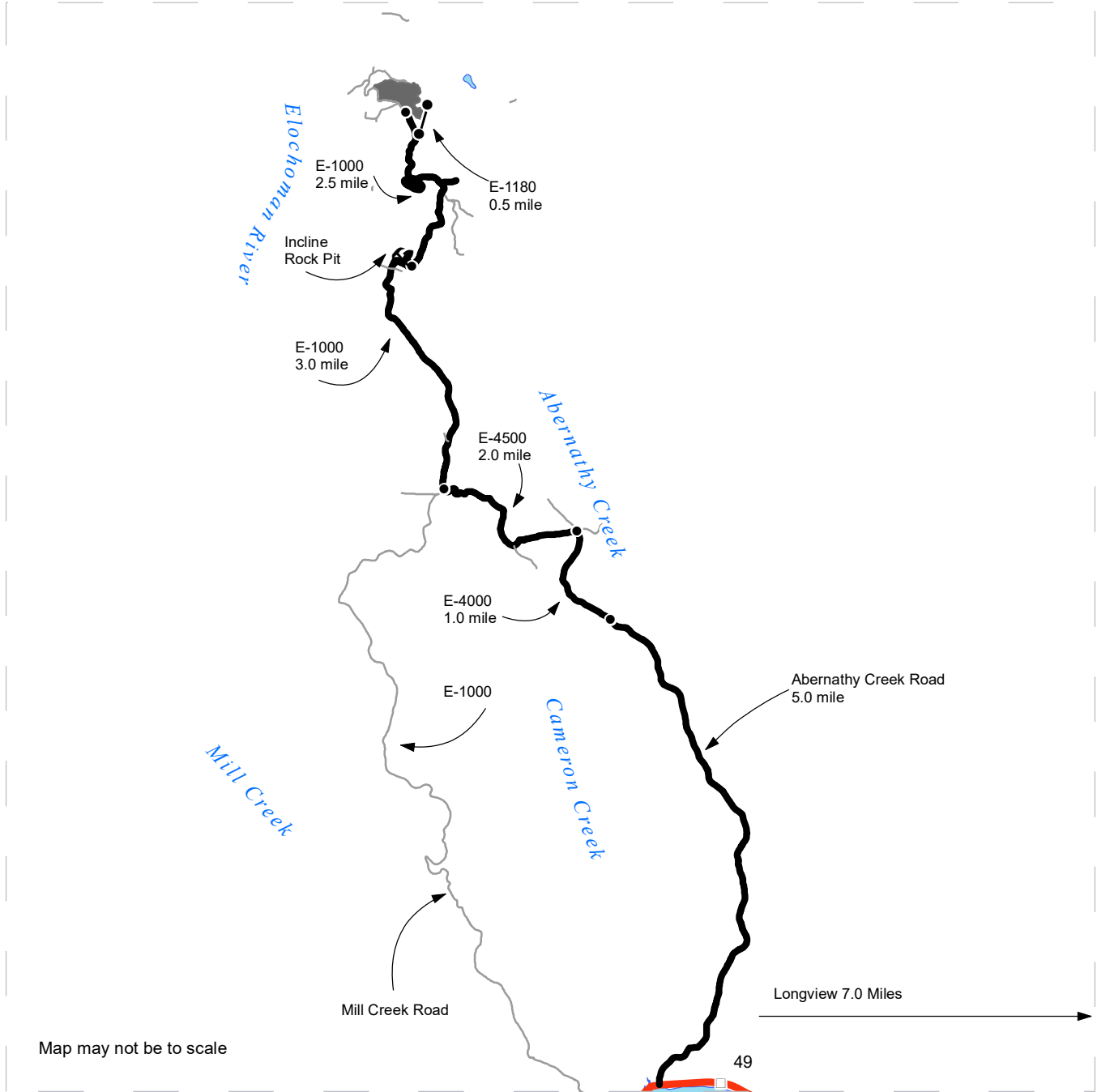
From State Route 4 (between mile post 47 and 48) turn north onto Mill Creek Road and follow for 1 mile. Merge left (west) onto Spruce Creek Road and follow for 0.6 miles. Turn right (north) onto Cathlamet Road, follow for 0.75 miles and the road will turn into Beaver Creek Road. Continue to follow this road for another 3.4 miles. Turn Right (north) onto Keyser/E-5000 Road go for 0.36 miles. Merge right (east) onto the E-5100 and follow for 0.33 miles to reach Unit 3 ROW. Continue on E-5100 for 1.32 miles. Make a slight right turn onto the E-2900 Road and follow for 0.65 miles to enter Unit 1. Turn left (north) onto the E-2920 and follow for 0.6 miles to be in Unit 2. You will also pass the Gung Ho Pit on the E-2920 Road.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

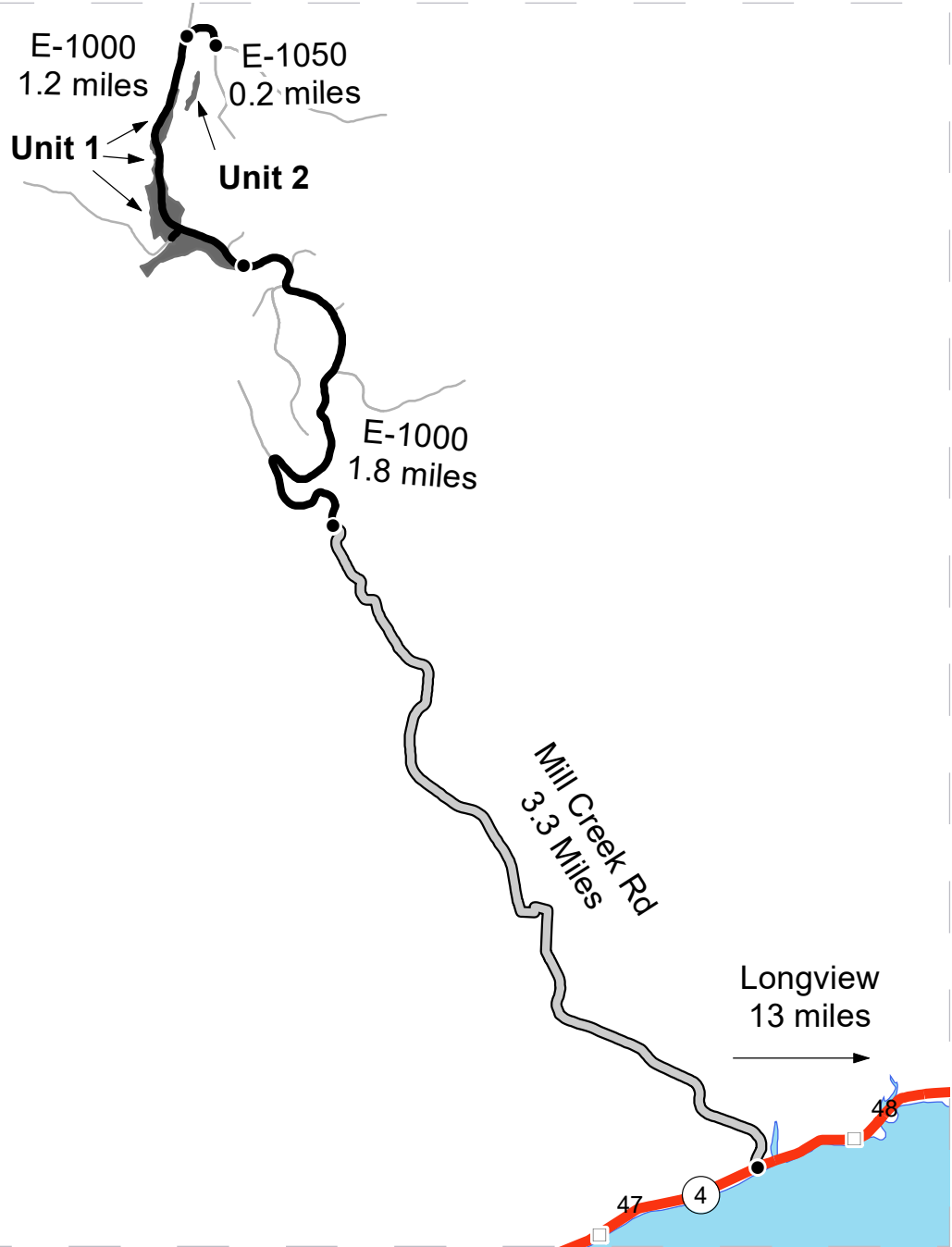
General Access: From State Highway 4 turn north at mile post 48 on Abernathy Creek Road follow for 5.0 miles, to where Abernathy Creek Road merges into the E-4000. Incline Rock Pit: Follow E-4000 for 1.0 miles, turn left onto E-4500 follow for 2.0 miles. The E-4500 merges into the E-1000 at shoe fly. Continue north on the E-1000 for 3.0 miles. the Incline Rock Pit is located at the top of a steep hill on the left. Unit 1: From the Incline Rock Pit continue on the E-1000 for 2.5 miles to the junction of the E-1180. To access Unit 1 park at the junction and the timber to the north of the E-1000 and the west of the E-1180 is Unit 1.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

From Route 4, drive north on Mill Creek Rd for 3.3 miles. Continue onto the E-1000. Continue north for 1.8 miles. Arrive at Unit 1.

Continue north for 1.2 miles. Turn east onto the E-1050. Continue for .2 miles, reaching a junction. Here begins the designated skid trail into Unit 2.
