## Introduction

The Timber Harvest Report provides an historical record of timber harvest activities by county, ownership class, product class and species. Used in conjunction with previous harvest reports, it reflects harvest trends over time. The objective of this report is to supply accurate timber harvest data for Washington State in a timely manner for use by forest managers, private and government analysts, and the general public.

---

## Organization of Data

Timber harvest volume is organized by county and then displayed by ownership class, product class and species.

### OWNERSHIP

Private forest ownerships are divided into three categories:

Forest Industry -- Companies and individuals operating wood-using plants with no acreage limitations.

Large Nonindustrial -- Companies and individuals not operating wood-using plants but with holdings of 1,000 or more acres.

Small Nonindustrial -- Companies and individuals not operating wood-using plants and having holdings of less than 1,000 acres.

The Department of Revenue, using forest excise tax returns, supplied the data for privately owned lands.

State is the designation used to report harvests from Department of Natural Resources-managed trust lands. The Department's Division of Timber Sales provided this data.

Other Non-federal includes public land owned by cities, counties, public utility districts, and state agencies other than the Department of Natural Resources.

BIA (Bureau of Indian Affairs) is the designation used to report timber harvest from the several Indian tribes (Colville, Quinault, Yakima, etc.) located in Washington State.

Other Federal represents various other federal agencies (military, National Park Service, Wildlife Service) selling timber for industrial wood harvest in the state.

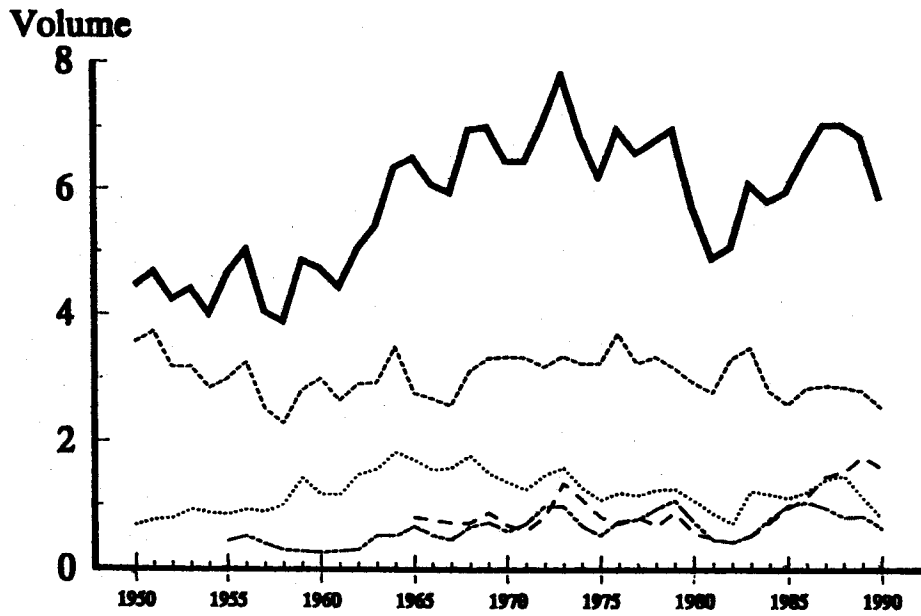

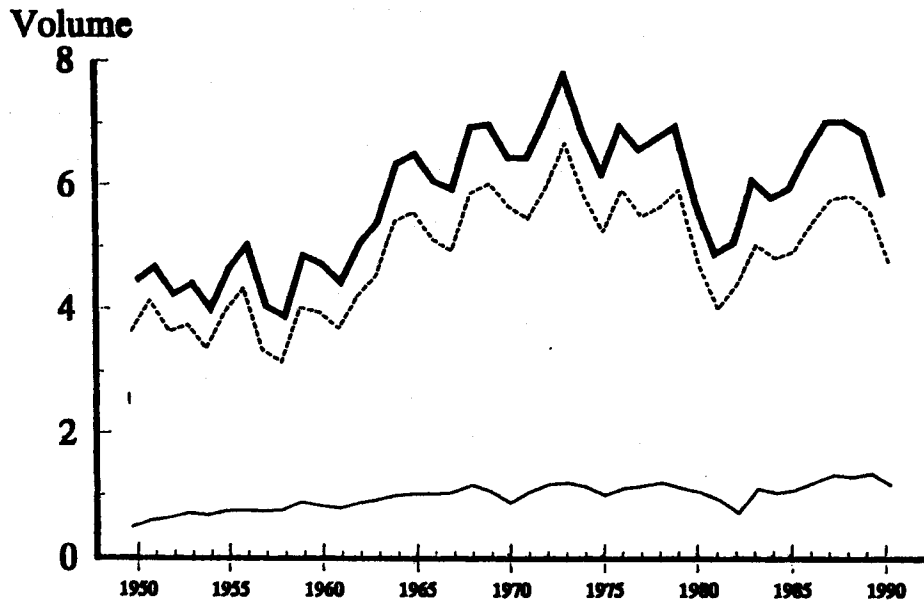

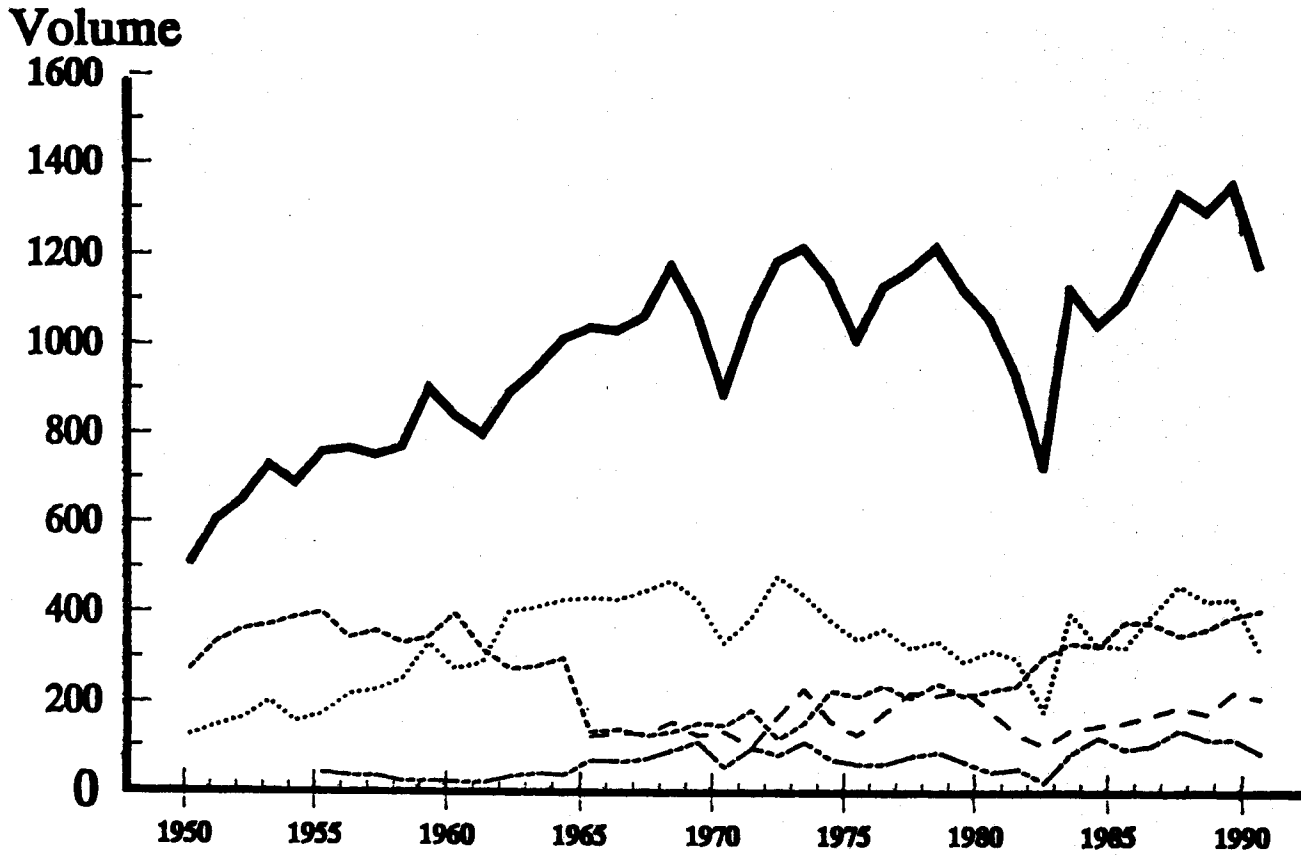

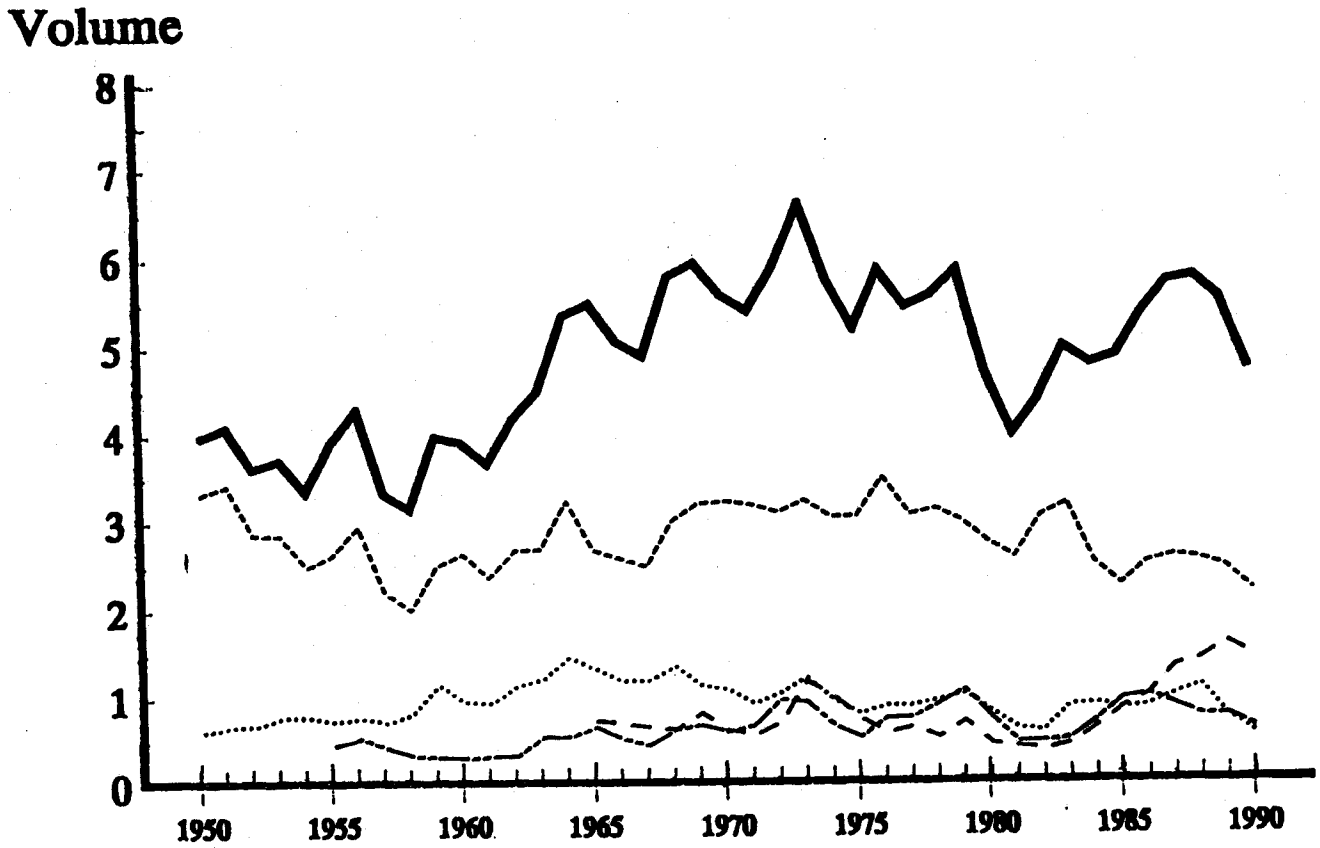
