## Preface

This is the 58th edition of the Washington Timber Harvest Report. It includes the details of harvest levels throughout the state .

The entire report is available in two formats (PDF files and Excel spreadsheets). The statistics are based on data collected by the Department of Revenue (DOR) to compile and compute the Forest Excise tax. The content is divided into 32 county tables and four statewide summary tables. Data include total harvest volumes by:

- county
- species
- ownership

Totals for Washington's timber harvests are also displayed by:

- Eastside log volume by ownership and county
- Westside volume by ownership and county (and statewide totals)
- Eastside volume by ownership and species
- Westside volume by ownership and species (and statewide totals)

Detailed timber harvest statistics are also displayed for the 32 counties (out of a total 39 counties) that reported timber harvests.

### Remembering David Larsen

I was saddened to hear about David Larsen's death on Feb. 20, 2014. David first worked for DNR in the 1960s during—and after—college, later returning to DNR in the mid-1970s. He was soft-spoken and friendly. I introduced myself to compliment him on the Washington Mill Survey and the Timber Harvest Report, which he compiled and edited. The reports caught my eye for their dense layers of statistical tables.

Over the years I helped David lay out the Mill Survey and, shortly before he retired in 2004, I was invited to take over editing.

Opening his file drawers, I was overwhelmed by the folders and pages of handwritten notes and table printouts. Over many months, I learned why he was so meticulous: more details and numbers bring you closer to the truth.

The Mill Survey wasn't flashy. There were a few photos, a sprinkling of charts and occasional drawings. But it was and is still probably the most thorough report of Washington's wood products industry. The report's pages were two colors, black numbers on white paper. So thick were the numbers that the pages looked like a blend of grey. Readers were assured that complete answers about the wood products industry could be found in his tables, such as the volume of lodgepole pine trees processed in eastern Washington sawmills.

The immensity of his labors is better grasped by the fact that he conducted his own survey. Before email and when Washington had nearly 700 mills (as opposed to 100 today), he mailed and faxed all the questionnaires and followed the mailings with phone calls. Most often he filled in the questionnaires over the phone.

David had a degree in Forestry Economics and it showed. During a forestry conference presentation, I displayed a table of the percentages of mill types that were dependent on various categories of forest owners for their logs. "It's a table only an economist could love," I commented.

At the same conference, I noticed that David's Mill Surveys were frequently cited by forestry professionals who were presenting their own reports, theories and even Ph.D. theses. They couldn't do their work until David did his.

The Mill Surveys featured analyses and occasional projections on timber prices, market opportunities and the strength of the construction industry. I believe the readers spent most of their time reading the statistics.

For David, the numbers were essential.

## Organization of Data

Timber harvest reports are listed by county, ownership class, and species.

Much credit is due to Washington's Department of Revenue (DOR) who provided complete information for this report, based on receipts of the Forest Excise Tax.

**Volume:** Timber volumes are reported in thousand board feet (MBF), Scribner scale.

### Ownership categories

#### Private

**Forest Industry** — Companies and individuals operating wood-processing plants (mills).

**Private Large** — Non-industrial companies and individuals not operating wood-processing plants but with statewide holdings totaling 1,000 or more acres.

**Private Small** — Non-industrial companies and individuals not operating wood-processing plants and owning less than a total of 1,000 acres.

(No data are available for tribal—and allotted—lands held in trust by the federal government, because they are not subject to the state Forest Excise Tax.)

#### Public

**State** — State-owned lands managed by the Department of Natural Resources for various trust beneficiaries (schools, etc.).

**Federal** — National forests, national parks and other federal lands (military, etc.)

**Other Public** — These are public lands owned by cities, counties, public utility districts and state agencies, other than state-owned lands managed by DNR.

### Species categories

**Eastern Washington** — Softwood species include Douglas-fir, hemlock, true firs (grand, noble, Pacific silver, and subalpine), ponderosa pine, lodgepole pine, other pines (western white, and whitebark), cedars, and other conifers (Alaska-cedar, Engelmann spruce, mountain hemlock, western hemlock). Eastern Washington hardwoods are red alder and (bigleaf maple, black cottonwood, quaking aspen, western paper birch, white alder, and willow).

**Western Washington** — Softwood species: Douglas-fir, western hemlock (including mountain hemlock), cedars (Alaska-cedar and Western redcedar), true firs (grand, noble, Pacific silver, and subalpine), spruce and other conifers (Engelmann spruce, Pacific yew, Sitka spruce, western juniper, western larch, western white pine, and whitebark pine), and ponderosa pine. Western Washington hardwoods include red alder, (bigleaf maple, bitter cherry, black cottonwood, Pacific madrone, Oregon ash, Oregon white oak, Pacific dogwood, quaking aspen, western paper birch, and willow.
