



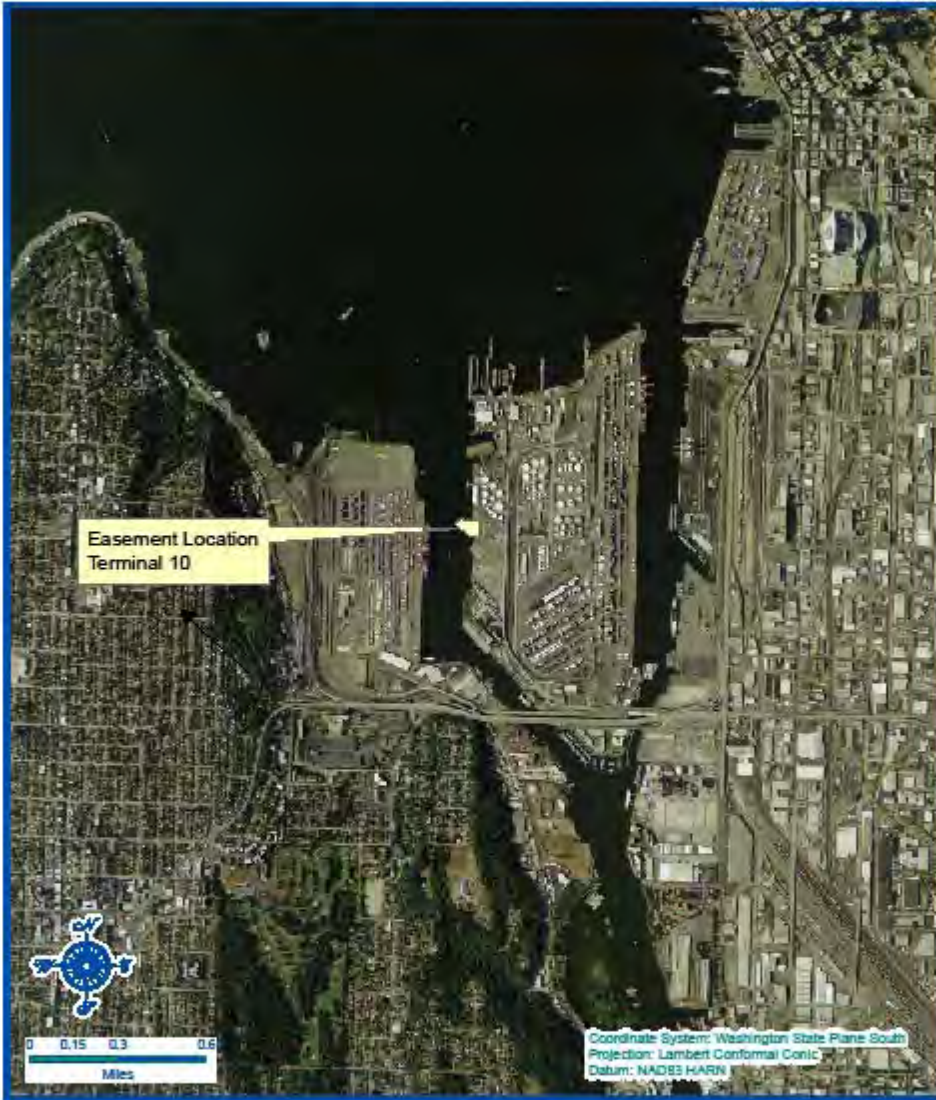

Application for Use of State-owned Aquatic Lands

Applicant Name: Port of Seattle

Description: The Port of Seattle (Port) is requesting the use of approximately 400 Sqft of State aquatic land to construct a storm water outfall in the area designated Terminal 10 a former Lockheed Shipbuilding site. The drainage area will be new pavement covering an existing upland contaminated site and allowing economic use to return to the former brown field site. The pipe terminus and discharge area is the site of an existing submerged contaminated sediment cap. Both sites are managed and monitored by the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The upland pavement is expected to improve protection of that site. The discharge area is heavily armored and will be reinforced by the pipe structure. EPA has approved the design. The discharge is part of the combined storm water system managed jointly under permit by the Port, City of Seattle and King County.
