Turn east onto Scotts Valley Road and drive for approximately 1.1 miles to Unit 2. Continue on Scotts Valley Road for approximately 1.2 miles to Unit 3. Just inside the Unit 3 boundary, turn south on E284116G. Drive past the green gate (past the private garage) for approximately 0.5 miles to Unit 1. From the intersection of E284116G and Scotts Valley Road, continue eastward on Scotts Valley for 0.2 miles and turn east through the yellow gate onto the E284116A road. Drive approximately 0.3 miles to the corner of Unit 4. Continue approximately 0.5 miles to Unit 5.

Unit 6 -7
