AHTANUM Green Dot Roads

Motorized use is restricted to green dot roads only. Travel on non-green dot roads is restricted to 100' from it's intersection with a green dot road. Travel on any roads not identified on the green dot map shall be considered off-road vehicle travel. Off road vehicle travel is prohibited unless otherwise posted. Ebikes as defined in RCW 46.04.169 are restricted to Green Dot Roads.


Green dot roads are posted with round green reflectors on white route markers.

Violators will be subject to prosecution.

ROAD MANAGEMENT AREA REGULATIONS

- * Limit vehicle camping to previously disturbed sites within 100 ft of a Green Dot Road.
- * No permanent camps or structures allowed. All man-made
- * No woodcutting without landowner permit. Do not cut live or standing dead trees under any circumstances. Down wood less
- that 12" diameter may be collected for on-site camp wood.
 * Follow posted regulations for campfires. Public users are liable at all times for their fires
- No fireworks or incendiary devices allowed at any time. * No littering, pack out your trash.
