AND ADOPTION OF EXISTING ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT**

**Description of current proposal:** Establish site for commercial harvesting of geoduck clams on state-owned sub tidal bedlands.

**Proponent:** WA Department of Natural Resources

**Location of current proposal:** Central Sound region at Harper and Agate Passage tracts in Kitsap County; South Sound region at Fauntleroy South in King County, Fox Island North and Cole Point tracts in Pierce County and Nisqually tract in Thurston County.

**Title of document being adopted:** The Puget Sound Commercial Geoduck Fishery Management Plan and Environmental Impact Statement.

**Agency that prepared document being adopted:** WA Department of Natural Resources and WA Department of Fish and Wildlife.

**Date adopted document was prepared:** May 2001

**Description of document (or portion) being adopted:** An Environmental Impact Statement and Management Plan written in compliance with SEPA guidelines describing the commercial fishing of sub tidal geoduck clams.
