

DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The proposal consists of the salvage of approximately 20 trees that were killed as a result of the Gray Road fire in 2023. Felling and chipping the trees is planned. No ground disturbing activities are associated with this project. This review covers the Forest Practices Application (FPA) activities as described in FPA No. 3027321.
