



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The proposal consists of 60 acres with an estimated 200 MBF of salvaged timber from the Goosmus Fire. This review covers the Forest Practices Application (FPA) activities as described in FPA No. 3027477 and the Qualified Expert Report for unstable slopes from Wild Goat Forestry included with the FPA.
