SUBJECT: SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Cougar VRH VDT Timber Sale #106246 and Forest Practice Application #2819529 proposal is for a variable retention harvest with a variable density thinning component, for a total harvest of 4,480 MBF from 148.6 acres. The proposal includes up to 4,796 feet of road construction and reconstruction (of which 803 feet are to be abandoned after completion of use, if built), and 17,906 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Located in Sections 10, 14, 15, 16, 22, 23, 24, Township 29 North, Range 07 East, W.M., Snohomish County.
