SUBJECT: SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Junia Timber Sale #106667 and Forest Practice Application #2819553 is a variable retention harvest (VRH) of 1,489 MBF from 41.6 (42) acres, as well as 7 MBF of right-of-way harvest from 0.7 acres of private land. Proposal includes 1,776 feet of road construction, up to 191 feet of temporary road construction (road to be abandoned after completion of use, if built), and 37,720 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Located in Sections 03, 04, 09, 10 and 11, Township 37 North, Range 03 East, and Sections 11, 12, and 14, Township 36 North, Range 03 East, W.M., Whatcom and Skagit Counties.
