SUBJECT: **SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Forest Practice Application #2618519/#2618524 and Alley Cat Timber Sale #104800 proposal includes approximately 96.9 acres (~2,894 MBF) of even-aged, uneven-aged, and right-of-way harvest and (~776 tons) biomass harvest within 14 harvest units. Planned harvest methods include shovel, tether, cable, tracked/rubber-tired skidder. The proposal includes approximately 10,755 feet of road construction, approximately 1,500 cy of spoils and 4 Ns crossings. Located in Sections 14, 15, 22, 23, 26, 27, Township 30 North, Range 07 West, W.M., Clallam County.
