This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

**Fish and Chips Timber Sale #104810 and Forest Practice Application #2618552 proposal consists of approximately 292 acres, removing 8,879 MBF of even-aged, uneven-aged, and right-of-way harvest within 5 harvest units. Planned harvest methods include shovel and leading end suspension cable. The proposal includes approximately 6,115 feet of road construction, 0.8 acres of pit expansion, one F crossing and one Ns crossing. Located in Sections 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, 36, Township 24 North, Range 11 West, Jefferson County.**
