## **DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

## **Description of proposal:**

The Blow Dry Salvage (TCB23) Timber Sale 30-103864 and associated Forest Practices Application is a blowdown and beetle kill salvage harvest composed of 2 Units, 46 acres in size, and located within the Port Angeles WAU. Total harvest acreage includes deduction for leave tree areas within gross traversed unit boundaries. Estimated harvest volume is 1606 MBF. The proposed sale is to be harvested by ground-based operations with equipment restrictions. The proposal involves 15,520 feet of pre-haul road maintenance, 610 feet of construction and 880 feet of reconstruction. Rock for road building activities is scheduled to come from State Lands; Pace Pit, and a commercial source. The Blow Dry sale is currently being considered as replacement acreage for an existing timber sale, TCB23. Forest Practice #2618490
