This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Doc Holliday Timber Sale #103767 and Forest Practice Application #2618292 proposal consists of six variable retention harvest units encompassing approximately 138 gross acres and a net harvest area of 74 acres, with a cruised volume of 2,309 MBF. The proposal includes approximately 5,005 feet of new road construction, 2,800 feet of reconstruction and 46,125 feet of pre-haul maintenance have been proposed to provide access to the sale area. Located in Section 06, 09, Township 30 North, Range 09 West, Sections 30, 31, Township 31 North, Range 09 West, and Section 25, Township 31 North, Range 10 West, W.M., Clallam County.
