DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal:

The Driftwood Delight timber sale, agreement #30-106463 and associated forest practice application #2618517, is a timber sale proposal located within the Hoko and Clallam River watershed administrative units (WAUs). The Driftwood Delight timber sale consists of 3 units of Variable Retention Harvest (VRH) with a cruised volume of 4,699 MBF. It encompasses roughly 259 acres, of which, 178 acres are VRH; 65 acres of riparian, wetland, and unstable slopes protection; 10 acres of leave tree areas; and 6 acres of existing roads. Approximately 28,155 feet of pre-haul maintenance, 2,640 feet of reconstruction and 4,320 feet of new road construction is proposed to provide access to sale area. Rock will be obtained from Mary Clark Pit and native sources. This sale will be harvested using ground-based and cable logging methods.

Proponent: Washington State Department of Natural Resources – Olympic Region

Location of proposal, including street address, if any:

The Driftwood Delight timber sale is located 5 miles west of Clallam Bay, WA in Clallam County on the CP-480 road system. The timber sale is located in sections 25 and 26 of Township 32N Range 13W, and in section 19 of Township 32N Range 12W. The Mary Clark Pit is located in section 32 of Township 30 Range 12W.

Lead agency: Washington State Department of Natural Resources

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21c.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

This DNS is issued under 197-11-340(2); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from December 12, 2024. Comments must be submitted by December 26, 2024.
