This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Salmonberry Surprise Timber Sale #106462 and Forest Practice Application #2618343 proposal consists of 2 variable retention harvest units and 3 units of right of way harvest encompassing approximately 180 gross acres, with a cruised volume of 4,432 MBF. The proposal includes approximately 12,215 feet of pre-haul maintenance and approximately 5,670 feet of new road construction is proposed to provide access to the sale area. Located in Section 36, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, and Section 01, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, W.M., Clallam County.
