This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

**Tree Well Timber Sale #104820 and Forest Practice Application #2618493 proposal consists of three variable retention harvest units encompassing approximately 272 gross acres and a net harvest area of 202 acres, with a cruised volume of 6,149 MBF. The proposal includes approximately 6,980 feet of new road construction, 995 feet of reconstruction and 20,960 feet of pre-haul maintenance have been proposed to meet access needs to the sale area. Located in Section 21, 27, 28, 29, 31, 32, Township 30 North, Range 06 West, W.M., Clallam County.**
