DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal:

The Tree Well timber sale, agreement # 30-104820 and associated Forest Practices application 2618493, is located in Clallam County, Washington approximately 5 miles south of Port Angeles off the PA-H-1000 road system. It encompasses approximately 272 gross acres with a cruised volume of 6,149 mbf. This proposal consists of three variable retention harvest units and is located in the Port Angeles and Sutherland-Aldwell WAUs. Within the proposal area, there are 54.7 acres of riparian management zones, 10.6 acres of leave tree areas, and 4.9 acres of existing roads. The net harvest acreage is 202 acres. Approximately 6,980 feet of new road construction, 995 feet of reconstruction, and 20,960 feet of pre-haul maintenance have been proposed to meet access needs to the sale area. The designated rock sources will be Overlook Pit and commercial sources.
