SUBJECT: SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Martin Way Commercial/Residential Development: DNR is currently intending to negotiate a ground lease with a developer. Lease negotiations are anticipated to occur within 2024-25 with potential development activity occurring as early as 2025. As part of the ground leasing action, the lessee is proposing to lease the entire 18.35 acres. Future development is likely to include multi-family housing on 14 acres and a mix of commercial and retail on the remaining 4+ acres adjacent to Martin Way. Located in Section 11, Township 18 North, Range 01 West, W.M., Thurston County.
