This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

**Forest Practice Application #2942612 proposal consists of 83.9 acres of even-aged timber harvest, fiber recovery, and cedar salvage, removing approximately 3,524 MBF and 500 tons. The proposal includes 1,900 feet of road construction. Proposals for future activities related to this site may require additional SEPA review. Located in Sections 16, 17, 20, 21, Township 12 North, Range 05 West, W.M., Lewis County.**
