This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Forest Practice Application #2942677 consists of 5 acres of right of way timber harvest (totaling approximately 100 MBF), and 3700 feet of road construction, 1000 cubic yards of spoils, and 4 stream crossings. This review only covers the FPA activities as described in #2942677. Proposals for future activities related to this site may require additional SEPA review. Located in Sections 21 and 22, Township 14 North, Range 02 West, W.M., Lewis County.
