This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Forest Practice Application #2942828 and Luna Tix Timber Sale #106422 proposal consists of 174 acres of even-aged timber harvest, removing approximately 8,038 MBF of timber. The proposal includes 2,850 feet of road construction, 2,850 feet of road abandonment, 4 stream crossings, and 5,000 cubic yards of spoils. Proposals for future activities related to this site may require additional SEPA review. Located in Sections 13, 14, 15, Township 11 North, Range 03 East, W.M., Lewis County.
