Description of proposal: Timber Sale Name : Luna Tix, Agreement # 30-106422. The proposal consists of 174 acres of even-aged timber harvest (totaling approximately 8038 MBF), 2850 feet of road construction, 2850 feet of road abandonment, 4 stream crossings, and 5000 cubic yards of spoils. This review only covers the Forest Practices Application (FPA) activities as described in FPA #2942828. Proposals for future activities related to this site may require additional SEPA review.
