This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Weatherman Timber Sale #105537 and Forest Practice Application #2942412 proposal is for a variable retention harvest with 97.9 acres in two units and 0.5 acres of right of way harvest in one unit, for a total of 98.4 acres in three units, removing approximately 4,554 MBF of timber. The proposal includes 3,835 feet of road construction and 8,390 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Located in Sections 01, 02, 11, 12, Township 15 North, Range 06 West, W.M. Grays Harbor County.
