DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Weatherman Timber Sale, Agreement No. 30-105537 and Forest Practices Application No. 2942412. This is a variable retention harvest with 97.9 acres in 2 units and 0.5 acres of right of way harvest in 1 unit, for a total of 98.4 acres in 3 units, removing approximately 4,554 MBF of timber, with 3,835 feet of road construction, and 8,390 feet of prehaul maintenance.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12 all in Township 15 North, Range 6 West, W.M., approximately 8 miles by road, West of Oakville, off the BR-2000, BR-3000 and BR-3100 road systems in Grays Harbor County, Washington.
