DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Woolly Mammoth Sorts Timber Sale, Agreement No. 30-107556 and Forest Practices Application No. 2942862. This is a variable retention harvest with 124 acres in 6 units, removing approximately 2,409 MBF of timber, with 1,101 feet of road construction, 4,535 feet of road reconstruction, and 9,178 feet of pre-haul maintenance.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: Sections 36 all in Township 7 North, Range 1 West, W.M., approximately 9 miles by road, west of Kalama, off the WO-15, WO-100, HF-099 and HF-100 road systems in Cowlitz County, Washington.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources
