



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The proposal is for a revision to an existing Surface Mine Reclamation Permit #70-012720 to decrease the site acreage from 300 acres to 254 acres. Sand and gravel mining, processing, crushing, washing, crusher, wash plant, concrete batch plant and asphalt plants may all utilize the site either as portable or stationary facilities. The site will be reclaimed to an industrial subsequent use.

Proponent: CPM Development Corp.

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The site is located at 8153 North Idaho Road, Newman Lake, WA within the SE quarter of Section 24 and all quarters of Section 25, Township 26 North, Range 45 East, Willamette Meridian, in Spokane County.

Lead agency: Department of Natural Resources

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21c.030(2)(c).
