This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Forest Practice Application #2423963 is for approximately 13 acres of even-aged harvest with an estimated 300 MBF of timber being removed utilizing ground-based harvesting methods. Approximately 475 feet of road construction is included. Forest Practices rule-identified unstable landforms are located adjacent to and within the proposed project area. Located in Section 17, Township 16 North, Range 05 East, W.M., Pierce County.
