**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

**Description of proposal:** Forest Practices Application/Notification No. 2424167, Brewed Awakening #30-104865.

This proposal is for approximately 143 acres of even-aged harvest and 50 acres of uneven-aged harvest with an estimated 4,510 MBF<sup>1</sup> of timber being removed, utilizing ground and cable based harvesting methods. The proposal includes a 0.1-acre rock pit. Forest Practices rule-identified unstable landforms are located adjacent to and within the proposed project area.
