## **DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

Description of proposal: Forest Practices Application/Notification No. 2424196, Tuckered Out #30-103628

This proposal is for approximately 55 acres of even-aged harvest with an estimated 3,500 MBF<sup>1</sup> of timber being removed utilizing ground based and cable harvesting methods. Approximately 2,164 feet of temporary road construction is included. Forest Practices rule-identified unstable landforms are located adjacent to and within the proposed project area.
