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DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: 2510 Cedar Salvage Timber Sale #30-106384 and associated Forest Practice Application No. 2424053; salvage of illegally felled western red cedar trees within 25 acres in two units, removing approximately 48 MBF of merchantable timber. Road work associated with this proposal consists of 22,611 feet of required post-haul maintenance, as necessary.

Proponent: Department of Natural Resources, State Lands

This proposal is located in Sections 2, 3 and 10 in Township 24 North, Range 03 West, W.M. This proposal is located approximately 19 miles by road northwest of Hoodsport off Highway 101, within Mason County. See the associated Forest Practices Application and driving map.
