SUBJECT: SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Broke Timber Sale #105211 and Forest Practice Application #2423996; more than 281 acres considered for harvest was reduced to 190 net acres consisting of five variable retention harvest units, removing approximately 7,020 MBF of merchantable timber. Road work associated with this proposal consists 2,531 feet of required reconstruction, 107,479 feet of required pre-haul maintenance, 520 feet optional reconstruction, and 520 feet of required abandonment, if reconstructed. Located in Sections 01, 02, 03, 04, 09, 10 and 11, Township 17 North, Range 04 West, W.M., Grays Harbor and Thurston Counties.
