## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal:** Broke Timber Sale #30-105211 and associated Forest Practice Application No. 2423996; more than 281 acres considered for harvest was reduced to 190 net acres consisting of five variable retention harvest units, removing approximately 7,020 MBF of merchantable timber. Road work associated with this proposal consists of 2,531 feet of required reconstruction, 107,479 feet of required pre-haul maintenance, 520 feet optional reconstruction, and 520 feet of required abandonment, if reconstructed.

**Proponent:** Department of Natural Resources, State Lands

**Location of proposal, including street address, if any:**

This proposal is located in Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, and 11 in Township 17 North, Range 04 West, W.M. This proposal is located approximately eight miles by road east of Malone off Highway 12, within Grays Harbor and Thurston Counties. See the associated Forest Practices Application and driving map.

**Lead agency:** Department of Natural Resources, State Lands

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21c.030(2)(c).
