SUBJECT: SEPA LEAD AGENCY & DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Rockit Launch SWT Timber Sale #106713 and Forest Practice Application #2424161 proposal is for a harvest of 281 net acres consisting of nine small wood thinning units, and one right-of-way unit, removing approximately 1,806 MBF of merchantable timber. The proposal includes 44,415 feet of required prehaul maintenance, 3,405 feet of required abandonment, if constructed/reconstructed, 1,641 feet of optional construction, 1,764 feet of optional reconstruction, and 350 feet of optional pre-haul maintenance. Located in Sections 02, 03, 04, Township 14 North, Range 06 East, and Sections 28, 29, 33, 36, Township 15 North, Range 06 East, W.M., Lewis and Pierce Counties.
